CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. 8/-92

TO

All Collector of Customs

Service/Division and Section Chiefs and

All Others Concerned

SUBJECT

Creation of a Seized and Abandoned Motor Vehicles Office, Office of the Commissioner

To generate optimum revenue for the government on seized and abandoned motor vehicles and to better protect the government's interest on these valuable assets, there is hereby created under the Office of the Commissioner, a Seized and Abandoned Motor Vehicles Office which shall be responsible for the following:

- To take physical custody of all seized and abandoned motor vehicles and maintain appropriate records necessary for the effective monitoring, supervision and control until they shall have been legally disposed of;
- In coordination with the Law Division and other offices of concerned ports, to obtain soonest possible resolution of the cases so that the vehicles maybe legally disposed of at the earliest possible time;
- Jin coordination with the Auction and Cargo Disposal Divisions of said ports, to work for the immediate disposal of the legally disposable vehicles with the end in view of obtaining optimum revenue for the port;
- 4) To take operational control of Warehouse 11 South Harbor and other warehouses that may be later utilized for the purpose of this Order; and
- 5) To improve the security measures in Warehouse 11 and similar other warehouses with the objective of insuring that the vehicles are not cannibalized nor parts and accessories thereof stolen/pilfered.

Mangrif

The Office shall prepare an overall plan and weekly report on their progress towards the accomplishment of the objectives set forth in this Order.

All Offices in the Bureau are hereby enjoined to extend all assistance necessary to the Office and its personnel so that the objectives of this Order may be achieved.

This Order shall take effect immediately.
