CUSTOMS MEMORANDUM ORDER NO. _____!4 - 2017____.

SUBJECT: ABOLITION OF COMMAND CENTER AND AUTHORIZATION TO ISSUE ALERT ORDERS

The Command Center (ComCen) created under Customs Special Order (CSO) No. 45-2016 is hereby abolished.

The Customs Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 23-2016, which provides that only the Office of the Commissioner through the ComCen has the power to issue Alert Order, and Customs Special Order No. 45-2016 are hereby repealed.

All other powers and functions conferred upon ComCen by CSO No. 45-2016 shall henceforth be exercised and performed by the corresponding offices and officials of the Bureau pursuant to Customs Modernization and Tariff Act and Executive Order No. 127, series of 1987.

To ensure trade facilitation and immediately act on information about possible violation of customs laws and regulations, the following Customs Officials are hereby authorized to issue Alert Orders:

- 1. Customs Commissioner or his authorized representative
- 2. Deputy Commissioner, Intelligence Group (IG)
- 3. Deputy Commissioner, Enforcement Group (EG)
- All District Collectors, for shipments arriving within their District and subports

The grounds for the issuance of Alert Orders and other provisions in the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA), and all pertinent laws, issuances, rules and regulations shall be strictly observed.

The provisions of Customs Memorandum Order No. 35-2015 on the procedure for issuance and lifting of Alert Orders which are not in conflict with this CMO and which have not been previously revoked shall remain effective.

To provide the Commissioner with timely information and monitoring on all issued and lifted Alert Order, all authorized Officers who issue Alert Order are

directed to submit report to the Office of the Commissioner thru email address comm.boc@gmail.com using the attached format:

 Summary of all issued Alert Order within 24 hours upon issuance of Alert Order

2. Summary of all examined alerted shipment within 24 hours upon the

completion of the examination

3. Summary of shipment not examined, within 48 hours from the time the consignee or broker was notified of the Alert Order.

In cases where the physical examination of alerted shipments were not conducted within forty-eight hours from issuance of the Alert Order, the status report should also indicate the reason for the delay in the conduct thereof.

This Order shall take effect immediately.


