WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION

Greetings!

WHEREAS, on 26 January 2022, a shipment from Malacca, Malaysia said to contain "SAMPLE TUPPERWARE" consigned to a certain JACENT MENDOZA under House Airway Bill No. 813529251262 arrived at the Federal Express (FedEx) Clark Hub. The same was subjected to non-intrusive examination and noted for physical examination;

WHEREAS, on even date, Acting Customs Examiner Irish Shane Escritor conducted physical examination on the subject shipment in the presence of authorized representatives from FedEx and AAI which led to the following findings:

AS DECLARED IN THE AIRWAY BILL	AS FOUND
ONE (1) SAMPLE TUPPERWARE	Four (4) tupperware containing two (2) male and two (2) female Live Bearded
Value: MYR 100.00 Gross Weight: 0.40 KGS	Dragon on tissue papers

WHEREAS, further verification of the documents submitted revealed that said **undeclared live bearded dragons** lacked the necessary Sanitary and Phytosanitary (SPS) permit and Veterinary Health Certificate (VHC) from the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) prior importation;

WHEREAS, said package containing the said breaded dragons were turned over to Ecosystems Management Specialist II Karen Justine R. Ramos of DENR for rehabilitation and care;

WHEREAS, on 28 January 2022, the Office of the District Collector received a Memorandum dated 27 January 2022 from Ms. Escritor, Acting Customs Examiner, thru Karl S. Cortes and Atty. Danilo G. Ballena Jr., FedEx Special Duty Collector and Acting Deputy Collector for Assessment, respectively, recommending the issuance of a Warrant of Seizure and Detention (WSD) against the subject shipment for violation of Sections 118 (g), 119 (f), 1113 par. i & I of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 10863 otherwise known as the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA) in relation to R.A. No. 9147 otherwise known as the Wildlife Resources Conservation and Protection Act;

WHEREAS, upon evaluation thereof, this office finds probable cause for the issuance of WSD against the subject shipment for violation of Sections 117, 1113 par. f, i, and I (3 & 4) of R.A. No. 10863 otherwise known as the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA) in relation to R.A. No. 9147 otherwise known as the Wildlife Resources Conservation and Protection Act;

WHEREFORE, by virtue of the power vested in me by law, and in compliance with pertinent Customs law, rules and regulations, you are hereby ordered to forthwith seize the aforementioned articles and take custody over the same pending termination of the seizure and forfeiture proceedings and/or until further order from this Office. In this connection, please be guided by Customs Memorandum Order No. 8-84, particularly on the matter of making a return of service and submission of inventory of list of the subject articles.
