NARRATIVE REPORT

March 6 - 12, 2020

Coll. Noli P Santua Jr., Officer-in-Charge, Port of Iloilo, participated in the Video Conference together with Commissioner Rey Leonardo B. Guerrero, Deputy Commissioner, District Collectors and Service Collectors on Monday, March 9, 2020 at 7:30 A.M. to 10:30 A.M.

Coll. Noli P Santua Jr., Officer-in-Charge, Port of Iloilo, conducted an ocular inspection of the office space at Quezon Street, Iloilo City on March 9, 2020, being offered by IBC International Builders Corp. as the lowest bidder as the Bids and Awards Committee (BOC-BAC) invited interested parties to submit quotations for the negotiated procurement of lease of office space for BOC – Port of Iloilo.

Coll. Noli P Santua Jr., Officer-in-Charge, Port of Iloilo, together with Engr. Jose Ceterio Elgaran of Philippine Port Authority (PPA) conducted an ocular inspection of the proposed office site of BOC- Port of Iloilo as well as the ingress and egress of the property located at Iloilo Commercial Port Complex (ICPC), Loboc, Lapaz, Iloilo City on March 10, 2020.

Coll. Noli P Santua Jr., Officer-in-Charge, Port of Iloilo, together with Deputy Commissioner Donato B. San Juan, IAG, had an initial meeting on March 11, 2020 at the Head Office, Bureau of Customs, Port Area, Manila, before proceeding to the PPA, Head Office, to meet PPA General Manager Ray Daniel R. Santiago and PPA Iloilo Port Manager Eduardo P. Goles for discussion and subsequent finalization of the Deed of Usufract regarding the 2,442 sq. m. lot allotted to the Bureau of Customs, Port of Iloilo.

Coll. Noli P Santua Jr., Officer-in-Charge, Port of Iloilo, together with Deputy Commissioner Donato B. San Juan, IAG, PPA General Manager, PPA Iloilo Port Manager and their Legal Counsel had a meeting at the Conference Room, PPA, Head Office, Port Area, Manila at 10:30 A.M., March 11, 2020. Our Deputy Commissioner presented the important issues and concerns of the BOC regarding the Deed of Usufract and the Lot to be provided to BOC, Port of Iloilo by the Philippine Ports Authority.

For this week, the entire district has a total of Seventeen (17) entries filed; export and formal entries.

At the main office, Five (5) formal entries were filed, One(1) entry was completed and Four (4) entries in progress; No Informal entry was filed; and One (1) Export entry was filed and completed.

For the Sub-port of Pulupandan, Three (3) Formal entries were filed and completed; No Informal entry was filed; and Four (4) Export entries were filed, One (1) entry in progress and Three (3) entries were completed.

There are no reports for balikbayan boxes, auctions, alert orders and apprehensions.
