## NARRATIVE REPORT

June 14-20, 2019

Coll. Gerardo A. Campo, Officer-in-Charge, Port of Iloilo, attended a meeting and ocular inspection together with Atty. Ramon Rory Antiojo-OIC, Port Operations Division, Port of lloilo and Representatives from Port Operations Service (POS), AOCG, Bureau of Customs, Manila at La Filipina Uygongco Corporation Wharf, Quarantine Road, Brgy. Progreso, Lapaz, Iloilo City on June 20, 2019 relative to their application for accreditation as Authorized Customs Facility.

For this week, the entire district has a total of Thirty Two (32) entries filed; export and formal entries.

At the main office, Eight (8) formal entries were filed; Four (4) entries were in progress and Four (4) entries were completed; Three (3) Informal entries were filed and were completed; and Three (3) Export entries were filed and completed.
