# *Section VII. Technical Specifications*

## STATEMENT OF COMPLIANCE TO TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

### A. INSTRUCTION:

The bidder must state in the last column opposite each parameter and required specifications either “Comply” or “Not Comply”. All pages shall be properly signed. Bidders must state here either “Comply” or “Not Comply” against each of the individual parameters of each Specification stating the corresponding performance parameter of the equipment offered. Statements of “Comply” or “Not Comply” must be supported by evidence in a Bidders Bid and cross-referenced to that evidence. Evidence shall be in the form of manufacturer’s un-amended sales literature, unconditional statements of specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer, samples, independent test data etc., as appropriate. A statement that is not supported by evidence or is subsequently found to be contradicted by the evidence presented will render the Bid under evaluation liable for rejection. A statement either in the Bidders statement of compliance or the supporting evidence that is found to be false either during Bid evaluation, post-qualification or the execution of the Contract may be regarded as fraudulent and render the Bidder or supplier liable for prosecution subject to the provisions of ITB Clause above goods manufactured by us.

2.	<p><b><u>PARAMETERS FOR POST-QUALIFICATIONS, ACCEPTANCE TEST, AND EVALUATION:</u></b></p>	

**A. NUMBER OF SAMPLES SUBJECT TO EVALUATION AND TEST FIRING:**

- I. For post-qualification: Two (2) sample units of the same product are to be delivered.
- II. For acceptance: Ten percent (10%) of the goods delivered will be chosen at random by the Team Inspection and Acceptance Committee.

**B. PRE-TEST FIRING:**

- I. Procedure: Conduct visual and dimensional inspection to determine the actual dimensions, weight, and firearms characteristics vis-à-vis the required technical specifications. Firearms will be fired with 50 rounds each.
- II. Purpose: Ascertain if the submitted sample firearms conform with the required technical specifications.
- III. Standard: After the initial firing, the pistols must have no evidence of burrs and bulges in the bore and or exterior rim of the barrel.

**C. ACCURACY TEST:**

- I. Procedure: Sample pistol will be fired using a machine rest or its equivalent at a distance of 25 meters. Firearms will be fired with 100 rounds each.
- II. Purpose: To determine the accuracy of the pistol using machine rest or equivalent.
- III. Standard: Must not exceed the maximum mean radius square (mrs) of 6 inches.

**D. INTERCHANGEABILITY TEST:**

- I. Procedure: Major parts of pistols (slide, barrel, recoil, spring, and receivers) will be interchanged and then fired with 50 rounds each.
- II. Purpose: To determine the reliability of the pistol when parts from identical weapons are interchanged.
- III. Standard: The pistol must function properly without any bidding of moving parts.

**E. FUNCTIONAL TEST:**

- I. Procedure: For post-qualification purposes, sample items will be fired using fifty (50) rounds each, and malfunction will be recorded. For acceptance purposes, sample units will be fired using sixteen (16) rounds each per unit.

1.1. Recording Format	Video and audio to record and export in a standard, open, non-

	<p>proprietary format, including both Codec and Container, such that it can be replayed in freely available software (e.g., VLC player) without processing or conversion. Standard open formats should be used for interoperability. Examples include MP4 and MKV. Data formats that can only be viewed within manufacturer-specific replay software are not recommended.</p> <p>VGA, HD 720P, and 1080 HD are predominant standard resolutions. The higher the resolution, the more storage is needed. Estimates below were created assuming H.264 compression with medium to high motion at 30 frames per second (fps) derived using a heuristic formula widely used in industry. Actual storage utilized is dependent on scene complexity and the motion of the video captured. Consider what sort of analysis may be conducted on the video before selecting a resolution.</p>

1.3. Video Encoding / Compression	<p>Use the lowest possible amount of compression in order to maximize the amount of information available to law enforcement. Consider what sort of analysis may be conducted on the video before selecting video encoding or compression. Examples include MPEG-4, and H.264. H.264 is an improvement over MPEG-4 compression. Moreover, High-efficiency Video coding should be supported.</p>		

1.4. Frame rate	30 frames per second (fps) is a standard video frame rate. Higher recording speeds capture more motion detail but require increased storage. Frame rates lower than 25 fps suffer from increased motion blur.
1.5. Horizontal Field of View	Adequate to capture a majority of activity at a reasonable distance. This would likely require at least a 90-degree field of view. Wide angle lenses capture more of a scene, but distort the view and lose detail towards the edges of the frame. Software tools may be required to properly analyze or view the video from extremely wide-angle video.
1.6. Camera Focus	The device should be able to focus on all objects from about 1 foot away to infinity. Continuous autofocus or fixed focus should be employed for usability. Manual settings should be avoided as they can distract the user. Motion jitter and blur can be significant when the camera is moving. Automatic image stabilization can reduce this effect.
1.7. Audio Quality	The system is capable of clearly capturing conversational speech at a distance of not less than 3 feet without wind or excessive background noise.
1.8. Separate Audio and Resolution and Encoding Compression	If the device will be used in a mode to record audio only, compressed audio requires less storage than video (4-60 MB per hour per microphone depending on desired quality). If high speech quality is needed, a sampling rate of at least 16 kHz with at least 24-bit capture is suggested per microphone. Higher values might be necessary to capture increased fidelity at a distance. Standard open encoding with speech quality resolution suggested. Examples include MP3, WMA and AAC.
1.9. Recording Triggering	Cameras could record continuously or be user-triggered or event-triggered. Cameras take time to start

		recording video after being powered on and after recording is initiated. This recording latency period should be minimal
	1.10. Night-time/Low Light Functionality	The quality of video footage recorded in low light or night conditions should be usable. Visible flash and infrared illumination can increase the quality of video taken at night but will affect battery life. Low-light filtering, infrared, near-infrared, and other low-light compensation technologies or mechanical filters can increase the quality of video taken in low light and severe weather conditions but can affect scene and motion detail.
	1.11. Synchronization	The device is capable of recording audio simultaneously and time synchronized with the video. Consider the additional information that should be collected with the recorded material. Automatically generated data about the wearer, location, date, and time can be collected and packaged in video format. The device clock must be synchronized with an external universal clock, either GPS or another source, when the unit is plugged in for absolute time of day to ensure accuracy.
	1.12. Tamper Resistance	The device prohibits recordings from being edited or deleted and should not overwrite existing data before they have been transferred. Systems that can export a hash value of files being transferred may provide an enhanced capability to demonstrate tamper resistance. Standard encryption such as AES can be employed to protect data and improve the management
