ADDENDUM NO. 1

SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF PETROLEUM, OIL AND LUBRICANTS

This Addendum No. 1 dated 25 October 2022 is issued to clarify, modify or amend items in the Bid Documents. This shall form an integral part of the Bid Documents.

ISSUES

Section I. Invitation to Bid

- 1. The Bureau of Customs (BOC) through the authorized appropriations under the FY 2022 General Appropriations Act intends to apply the sum of Twenty-Nine Million Nine Hundred Forty-Four Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php29,944,500.00) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract "Supply and Delivery Petroleum, Oil and Lubricant". Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the bid opening.
- 5. A complete set of Bidding Documents may be acquired by interested Bidders on June 22, 2022 from the given address and website below and upon payment of the applicable fee for the Bidding Documents, pursuant to the latest guidelines issued by the GPPB, in the amount of Fifty Thousand Pesos (P50,000.00). The Procuring Entity shall allow the bidder to present its proof of payment for the fees to be presented in person.
- 7. Bids must be duly received by the BAC Secretariat through manual submission at the office address as indicated below on or before October 31, 2022, 9:30 a.m. Late bids shall not be accepted.
- 9. Bid opening shall be on October 31, 2022, 10:00 a.m. at the given address below. Bids will be opened in the presence of the bidders' representatives who choose to attend the activity.

CLARIFICATION/AMENDMENTS

Section I. Invitation to Bid

GCC Clause 1 - e-POL Cards

Supplier must have available electronic card (e-POL or Contingency Card purchase system/facility) which can be used in all their e-POL capable service stations nationwide. Billing for using e-POL card will be based on the current selling/pump price of host gasoline station (at the time of purchase). Rebates percentage shall apply on using e-POL card in reference to current Supplier's offer that the PROCURING ENTITY may benefit from.

Rebates/loyalty points shall apply on using e-POL card in reference to current Supplier's offer that the PROCURING ENTITY may benefit from.

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Section VII. Technical Specifications

Bidders must state here either "Comply" or "Not Comply" against each of the individual parameters of each Specification stating the corresponding performance parameter of the goods offered. Statements of "Comply" or "Not Comply" must be supported by evidence in a Bidders Bid and cross-reference to that evidence. Evidence shall be in the form of manufacturer's unamended sales literature, unconditional statements of specification and compliance issued by the manufacturer, samples, independent test data, etc., as appropriate. A statement that is not supported by evidence or is subsequently found to be contradicted by the evidence presented will render the Bid under evaluation liable for rejection. A statement either in the Bidder statement of compliance or the supporting evidence that is found to be false either during Bid evaluation, post qualification or the execution of the contract may be regarded as fraudulent and render the bidder or supplier liable for prosecution subject to the provision of ITB Clause 3.1(a)(ii) and/or GCC.

1	e-POL Card is an electronic card used to withdraw cashless transaction of fuel allocations in any of supplier's fleet-capable service stations nationwide.	*
2	Supplier must have a minimum of 600 strategically located stations nationwide with the <i>e</i> -POL card capability that allows card transactions as may be required to support the PROCURING ENTITY's requirements as indicated in Section VI: Schedule of Requirements.	
3	Preferably with a security feature that ensures that the <i>e</i> -POL cards cannot be duplicated or cloned in any way.	
4	Have the capability of an offline system that does not rely on a server connection for every transaction.	
5	Supplier must generate consumption summary reports for every card transaction (name of station, address, quantity, amount, products availed of, and plate number).	
6	e-POL cards must have flexibility for assigning product restrictions and purchase limits as per PROCURING ENTITY'S requirement.	
7	Have a web-based data tracking or monitoring system reflecting the monthly purchases of the agency.	
8	Have a single invoice system for the agency's monthly purchases for administrative expediency.	
9	The PROCURING ENTITY shall have control/access on:
