

DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"3-AXLE AIR SUSPENSION 20 FEET TIPPING CONTAINER CHASSIS, Model: SU.T16.024"

Based on the technical information and photograph of the actual product submitted, subject article is essentially a semi-trailer consisting of a steel chassis, three (3) axles (air suspension system with a pair of wheels per axle), a 2-inch king pin for fifth-wheel coupling to a road tractor, a parking brake, a 25-tonne capacity support leg in front, and accessories. It is also fitted with a 45-degree telescopic tipping system, powered by a 24 V hydraulic



engine, for ease of unloading goods. Subject article has a maximum payload capacity of 27 tonnes and is to be coupled to a road tractor.

REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 87.16 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers, among others, trailers and semi-trailers. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading includes trailers and semi-trailers. The most important types of trailers and semi-trailers falling in this group are those designed for use with motor vehicles. Trailers usually have two or more sets of wheels, and a coupling system mounted on the swivelling front wheels which steer the vehicles. Semi-trailers are fitted with rear wheels only, the forward end resting on the platform of the towing vehicle to which it is coupled by a special coupling device. The trailers falling here include, among others, self-unloading trailers for carrying different products (forage, manure, etc.), with a moving floor for unloading purposes.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 8716.39.99, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem.

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
