





"NECKRING BAR (SILICON BRONZE)"

Based on the technical specifications, product composition, and manufacturing process flowchart submitted, subject article is a sand-moulded copper alloy neckring bar consisting of two cylindrical halves, with or without cavities. It is composed, by weight, of the following:

Nickel	Aluminium	Zinc	Iron	Silicon	Lead/Manganese	Tin/Phosphorus	Copper
15%	9.5%	8.5%	1%	1%	0.25%	0.25%	64.5%

After its moulding process, subject article is packed and exported as a semi-finished product. It is to be milled and formed as neckrings for the fabrication of glass moulds and has the following specifications:

Outside diameter (mm)	89 - 139
Inside diameter (mm)	0 - 65
Length (mm)	420 - 458

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5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 74.19 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers other articles of copper. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers all articles of copper other than those covered by the preceding headings of this Chapter or by Note 1 to Section XV, or articles specified or included in Chapter 82 or 83, or more specifically covered elsewhere in the Nomenclature. This heading covers, among others, articles of copper of the types listed in the Explanatory Notes to headings 73.25 and 73.26.

Based on the brochure submitted, subject article is an instrument current transformer conforming to standard IEC-61869-2 class. It is an indoor-type current transformer used with electrical measuring instruments and/or electrical protective devices. Subject article has the following specifications:

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 85.04 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers electrical transformers, static converters (for example, rectifiers) and inductors. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers, among others, electrical transformers. Electrical transformers are apparatus which, without having any moving parts, transform, by means of induction and using a preset or adjustable system, an alternating current into another alternating current of different voltage, impedance, etc. Certain transformers are designed for particular purposes, e.g., matching transformers for matching the impedance of one circuit with that of another, and instrument transformers (current or voltage transformers, combined instrument transformers) used to step down or step up voltages or currents to the level of the connected equipment, e.g., measuring instruments, electricity meters or protective relays.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 8504.31.24, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 10% ad valorem.
