

DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"BENEO ORAFTI® P95"

Based on the brochure, manufacturing process flowchart, product composition, technical analysis of reducing sugar content, chemical characteristics, technical details, uses, and packaging information submitted. subject article is 100% oligofructose (CAS No. 308066-66-2), a short chain polymer of fructose, in the form of a white to slightly yellow powder. It consists of a mixture of molecules of fructose chains (Fn) and fructose chains with terminal glucose units (GFn) where "n" ranges from 2 to 8. Subject article is produced by partial enzymatic hydrolysis of raw inulin (extracted from chicory roots), followed by subsequent refining, then spray drying. Packed in 25-kg bags, subject article is a non-digestible carbohydrate that is used as an ingredient in various food applications, such as milk powder, infant and child formula, and bakery products, to improve their nutritional and technological profiles.

REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

The General Explanatory Notes to Chapter 39 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 state that polymers consist of molecules which are characterised by the repetition of one or more types of monomer units.

Furthermore, Note 6(b) to Chapter 39 states that in headings 39.01 to 39.14, the expression "primary forms" applies only to blocks of irregular shape, lumps, powders (including moulding powders), granules, flakes and similar bulk forms.

Heading 39.13 of the AHTN 2017 covers natural polymers (for example, alginic acid) and modified natural polymers (for example, hardened proteins, chemical derivatives of natural rubber), not elsewhere specified or included, in primary forms. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading also includes isolated amylopectin and isolated amylose obtained by the fractionation of starch.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 3913.90.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem.

This ruling modifies TCC (AR) No. 18-411 issued on 10 September 2018.

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
