



Packed in a 50-mL bottle placed in a box, subject article is applied to the face and neck in the morning and evening after using toner and essence to help hydrate, lighten, and reduce signs of aging.

"SHELL GTL SARAWAX SX70S"

Based on the product data sheet and technical catalogue submitted, subject article is a synthetic paraffin wax in the form of a white solid at ambient temperature with a maximum oil content of 0.5 %wt. It is produced by polymerization of linear alkane molecules from natural gas via the Fischer-Tropsch gas-to-liquids (GTL) technology. Packed in 25-kg boxes, subject article is suitable for a range of applications such as for hot melt adhesives, polyvinyl chloride (PVC) lubricants, printing inks, rubbers, tyres, candles, personal care, and packaging materials.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 27.12 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers, among others, paraffin wax, microcrystalline petroleum wax, slack wax, ozokerite, lignite wax, peat wax, other mineral waxes, and similar products obtained by synthesis or by other processes, whether or not coloured. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that the heading also includes products similar to those referred to in the heading and obtained by synthesis or by any other process (e.g., synthetic paraffin wax and synthetic microcrystalline wax).

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 2712.20.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of zero and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".
