

DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"PROMOTE™ NOTOX™ LS"

Based on the product label, manufacturing process flowchart, certificate of composition, product specifications, and certificate of feed product registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI) submitted, subject article is a mycotoxin binder in the form of a light to dark gray powder. It is composed of bentonite, clinoptilolite, and activated charcoal. Packed in 25-kg bags, subject article is to be added to feeds of swine, poultry, and ruminants at a rate of 0.5 to 1.5 kg per metric ton of feed.

REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 38.24 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers, among others, chemical products and preparations of the chemical or allied industries (including those consisting of mixtures of natural products), not elsewhere specified or included. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that the chemical or other preparations are either mixtures (of which emulsions and dispersions are special forms) or occasionally solutions. Aqueous solutions of the chemical products of Chapter 28 or 29 remain classified within those Chapters, but solutions of these products in solvents other than water are, apart from a few exceptions, excluded therefrom and accordingly fall to be treated as preparations of this heading. The preparations classified here may be either wholly or partly of chemical products (this is generally the case) or wholly of natural constituents.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 3824.99.99, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem.

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"REMDAC (REMDESIVIR FOR INJECTION 100MG/VIAL)"

Based on the product information, material safety data sheet, and photograph of actual product submitted, subject article is an off-white to white lyophilized powder composed of 100 mg of remdesivir, as active ingredient, with sodium hydroxide and hydrochloric acid (for adjusting the pH) and betadex sulfobutyl ether sodium, as excipients. Remdesivir is indicated for the treatment of coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19) in patients aged 12 years and older, with body weight of at least 40 kg, and with pneumonia and requiring supplemental oxygen. Available in 30-mL glass vials, subject article is to be administered by intravenous infusion after reconstitution with 19 mL of sterile water and further dilution with sodium chloride 9 mg/mL (0.9%) solution.



5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 30.04 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers medicaments (excluding goods of heading 30.02, 30.05 or 30.06) consisting of mixed or unmixed products for therapeutic or prophylactic uses, put up in measured doses (including those in the form of transdermal administration systems) or in forms or packings for retail sale. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers medicaments consisting of mixed or unmixed products, provided they are, among others, put up in measured doses or in forms such as tablets, ampoules, capsules, cachets, drops or pastilles, medicaments in the form of transdermal administration systems, or small quantities of powder, ready for taking as single doses for therapeutic or prophylactic use.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 3004.90.99, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 5% ad valorem and ASEAN-India Free Trade Area (AIFTA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "AI".

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"NATIVE TAPIOCA STARCH (FOOD GRADE)"

Based on the raw material list, product specifications, material safety data sheet, photograph of the product, and certification of usage submitted, subject article is 100% native tapioca (cassava) starch produced from fresh cassava roots. It is in the form of a white free-flowing powder packed in 25-kg, 50-kg, and 850-kg polypropylene or polyethylene bags. Subject article can be utilized in food and non-food applications, for example as a raw material in the preparation of glues used in the manufacture of corrugated cartons, pads, and partitions in the paper industry.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 11.08 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers, among others, starches. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that starches, which chemically are carbohydrates, are contained in the cells of many vegetable products. The most important sources of starch are the cereal grains (e.g., maize (corn), wheat and rice), certain lichens, certain tubers and roots (potato, manioc, arrowroot, etc.) and the pith of the sago palm. They are used as such in a wide variety of industries, especially the food, paper, paper converting and textile industries.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 1108.14.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 20% ad valorem and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D"

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"LAVENDER 43.0367-1"

Based on the product specifications, ingredients list, permission statement, and safety data sheet submitted, subject article is a mixture of odoriferous substances, fixatives, and solvent. It is in the form of a yellowish liquid with a characteristic lavender odour. Packed in 25-kg polycans, subject article is used as a raw material in the manufacture of household and personal care products (detergents, sanitizers, perfumes, etc.) to impart lavender odour.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 33.02 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers, among others, mixtures of odoriferous substances and mixtures (including alcoholic solutions) with a basis of one or more of these substances, of a kind used as raw materials in industry. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers the following mixtures provided they are of a kind used as raw materials in the perfumery, food or drink industries (e.g., in confectionery, food or drink flavourings) or in other industries (e.g., soapmaking), among others, mixtures, whether or not combined with a diluent or carrier or containing alcohol, of products of other Chapters (e.g., spices) with one or more odoriferous substances (essential oils, resinoids, extracted oleoresins or synthetic aromatics), provided these substances form the basis of the mixture.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 3302.90.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 1% ad valorem.

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
