#### 4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

#### "RANVET AMINOVITE® PLUS"

Based on the finished goods specifications, product composition, product data sheet, Certificate of Product Registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), and photograph of packaging submitted, subject article is a multivitamin supplement for horses in the form of a golden yellow powder with brown speckles and oily linseed smell. It is composed of di-calcium phosphate, linseed meal, sodium chloride, caster sugar, inactive dried yeast powder, vitamins, and minerals, among others. Available in 1 kg, 2.5 kg, 3 kg and 16 kg packaging, subject article is to be mixed thoroughly with feed at a dosage of 15 to 60 g daily to balance high grain diets and combat vitamin and mineral deficiency among horses.

# 5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 23.09 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers preparations of a kind used in animal feeding. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading includes, among others, preparations for supplementing (balancing) farm-produced feed (feed supplements). Farm-produced feed is usually rather low in proteins, minerals or vitamins. The preparations devised to compensate for these deficiencies, so as to ensure a well-balanced animal diet, consist of proteins, minerals or vitamins plus additional-energy feeds (carbohydrates) which serve as a carrier for the other ingredients. Although, qualitatively, these preparations have much the same composition as those in complete feeds, they are distinguished by a relatively high content of one particular nutrient.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 2309.90.20, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of zero and ASEAN-Australia-New Zealand Free Trade Area (AANZFTA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "AANZ".

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
