Based on the brochure and technical specifications submitted, subject article is a digital controller with aluminium front panel, light-emitting diode (LED) display, programming keys, LED light indicators, sockets for external connectivity, and processor for programming. It is designed and intended to be attached as a built-in controller for various computerized commercial cooking equipment, wherein it can control, among others, the temperature and the duration of the cooking process inside the cooking equipment. Subject article has the following specifications:

Heading 85.37 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers boards, panels, consoles, desks, cabinets and other bases, equipped with two or more apparatus of heading 85.35 or 85.36, for electric control or the distribution of electricity, including those incorporating instruments or apparatus of Chapter 90, and numerical control apparatus, other than switching apparatus of heading 85.17. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that the goods of this heading vary from small switchboards with only a few switches, fuses, etc. (e.g., for lighting installations) to complex control panels for machine-tools, rolling mills, power stations, radio stations, etc., including assemblies of several of the articles cited in the text of this heading.

"RANVET FOLACTIN BLUE®"

Based on the product composition, finished goods specifications, and product brochure submitted, subject article is a mineral supplement for stabled horses in the form of a white microcrystalline powder with minute bluish specks. It is composed of cobalt sulphate, lactose, calcium carbonate, di- and tricalcium phosphates, magnesium carbonate, copper sulphate, vitamin $D_3\,500\,K$ IU, folic acid, inositol, sodium fluoride, vanillin crystals, and potassium iodide, among others. Packed in 5-kg and 20-kg white pails, subject article is formulated to meet the specific needs of stabled horses. It is to be mixed thoroughly with feed at a dosage of 30 to 90 g daily, to rectify calcium and phosphorus deficiencies, and ensure sound bone, tendon, and ligament development.

"RANVET FOLACTIN RED®"

Based on the product composition, finished goods specifications, and product brochure submitted, subject article is a mineral supplement for horses in the form of a white microcrystalline powder with minute specks and a hint of vanilla odour. It is composed of calcium carbonate, di- and tricalcium phosphates, lactose, cobalt sulphate, vanillin crystals, and Vitamin D_3 500 K IU, among others. Packed in 5-kg and 20-kg white pails, subject article is formulated to meet the specific needs of paddocked and stud horses at all ages. It is to be mixed thoroughly with feed at a ratio depending on the age and gender of horses, to rectify calcium and phosphorus deficiencies, and ensure sound bone, tendon, and ligament development.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"RANVET SALKAVITE®"

Based on the product composition, brochure, and specifications submitted, subject article is a feed supplement for horses in the form of a cream-coloured microcrystalline powder. It is composed of tri-calcium phosphate; choline bitartrate; inositol; vitamins B₁ (thiamine mononitrate), B2, B3, B6, B12, and E50 ADS; rutin powder; and folic acid, among others. Packed in 180-g sachets and in 2-kg, 5-kg, and 16-kg white pails, subject article can be used as a feed or water additive, or as a pre-saline drench, to replace electrolytes, rectify B-group vitamin deficiencies, and to reduce dehydration, muscle fatigue, cramping, poor performance, delayed recovery following exercise, and tissue damage in horses.

Based on the technical specifications submitted, subject article is a fully programmable application controller that communicates on an RS-485 Local Area Network (LAN) using the BACnet Master Slave/ Token Passing (MS/TP) protocol. This controller is designed for a wide range of applications that have small local input/output (I/O) requirements and can also be tailored to specific applications by creating and modifying BACnet objects and Guarded Command Language (GCL)+ programs.
