

## 4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

### "SILIKOPHEN® P80/X"

Based on the safety data sheet, manufacturing process description, regulatory datasheet, technical background, technical catalogue, and packaging information submitted, subject article is a non-reactive solution of methyl phenyl silicone resin in the form of a clear to hazy liquid. It is composed of polysiloxane, xylene, isobutanol, ethylbenzene, and methanol. Packed in 50-kg drums, subject article is used as an ingredient in the manufacture of heat-stable coatings for industrial facilities, protective coatings, and coatings for ovens, furnaces, pipelines, and incinerators.

### 5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Note 6(a) to Chapter 39 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 states that in headings 39.01 to 39.14, the expression "primary forms" applies only to liquids and pastes, including dispersions (emulsions and suspensions) and solutions.

Heading 39.10 of the AHTN 2017 covers silicones in primary forms. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that the silicones of this heading are non-chemically defined products containing in the molecule more than one silicon-oxygen-silicon linkage, and containing organic groups connected to the silicon atoms by direct silicon-carbon bonds. They have a high stability and may be either liquid, semi-liquid or solid. The products include silicone oils, greases, resins and elastomers. Silicone resins are used mainly in the manufacture of varnishes, insulating or waterproof coatings, etc., where stability at high temperature is required. They are also used in the preparation of laminates with glass fibre, asbestos or mica as the reinforcing material, as flexible moulds and for electrical encapsulation.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 3910.00.20, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 1% ad valorem.

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
