4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"POWERCITY AUTOMATIC TRANSFER SWITCH, MODEL: PTS-800"

Based on the brochure and operator's manual submitted, subject article is an electrical apparatus consisting mainly of a microprocessor-based automatic controller, a solenoid-type transfer switch device, fuses, terminal blocks, power relays, and an automatic battery charger, housed in a metal enclosure. It has the following specifications:

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 85.37 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers boards, panels, consoles, desks, cabinets and other bases, equipped with two or more apparatus of heading 85.35 or 85.36, for electric control or the distribution of electricity, including those incorporating instruments or apparatus of Chapter 90, and numerical control apparatus, other than switching apparatus of heading 85.17. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that these consist of an assembly of apparatus of the kind referred to in the two preceding headings (e.g., switches and fuses) on a board, panel, console, etc., or mounted in a cabinet, desk, etc. They usually also incorporate meters, and sometimes also subsidiary apparatus such as transformers, valves, voltage regulators, rheostats or luminous circuit diagrams. The goods of this heading vary from small switchboards with only a few switches, fuses, etc. (e.g., for lighting installations) to complex control panels for machine-tools, rolling mills, power stations, radio stations, etc., including assemblies of several of the articles cited in the text of this heading.

"NUT HEX (10 MM), PART NO. 94002-10000-0S"

Based on the technical information submitted, subject article is a hexagonal nut made from carbon steel wire rods conforming to JIS G 3507 standards and with grade SWCH25K. With a nominal diameter of 10 mm, subject article is used for securing and fastening various materials including, among others, parts of a motorcycle.



5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 73.18 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers screws, bolts, nuts, coach screws, screw hooks, rivets, cotters, cotter-pins, washers (including spring washers) and similar articles, of iron or steel. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that the heading covers, among others, nuts. Nuts are metal pieces designed to hold the corresponding bolts in place. They are usually tapped throughout but are sometimes blind. The heading includes wing nuts, butterfly nuts, etc.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 7318.16.10, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 10% ad valorem and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".

The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers, among others, specialised heating or cooking apparatus which are not normally used in the household (e.g., counter-type coffee percolators, tea or milk urns, steam kettles, etc., used in restaurants, canteens, etc.; steam-heated cookers, hot-plates, warming cupboards, drying cabinets, etc.; deep-fat friers).
