

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"SCOTT'S EMULSION ORANGE FLAVOUR COD LIVER OIL (400 ML)"

Based on the certificate of analysis, product information, certificate of product registration from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), and sample submitted, subject article is a food supplement containing cod liver oil, vitamin A and D₃ oil concentrate, and calcium hypophosphite, among others. It is in the form of a smooth orange-colored emulsion and is formulated to provide the daily requirements of vitamins A and D, which are essential for growth and development. Packed in 400-mL amber polyethylene terephthalate (PET) bottles, subject article is recommended for adults and children (as young as one year old) at a dosage of 15 mL once to twice daily.



5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 21.06 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers food preparations not elsewhere specified or included. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading includes, *inter alia*, preparations, often referred to as *food supplements*, based on extracts from plants, fruit concentrates, honey, fructose, etc. and containing added vitamins and sometimes minute quantities of iron compounds. These preparations are often put up in packagings with indications that they maintain general health or well-being. Similar preparations, however, intended for the prevention or treatment of diseases or ailments are excluded (heading 30.03 or 30.04).

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 2106.90.72, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 7% ad valorem and an ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"KETCHUP CONC N OS"

Based on the safety data sheet, product information, and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is a mixture of spice and vegetable extractives and sunflower oil in the form of a clear yellow liquid. Packed in 18-kg high density polyethylene (HDPE) pails, subject article is used as a flavouring in the manufacture of ketchup and ketchup blends.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 33.02 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers, among others, mixtures of odoriferous substances and mixtures (including alcoholic solutions) with a basis of one or more of these substances, of a kind used as raw materials in industry. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers the following mixtures provided they are of a kind used as raw materials in the perfumery, food or drink industries (e.g., in confectionery, food or drink flavourings) or in other industries (e.g., soapmaking), among others, mixtures of one or more odoriferous substances (essential oils, resinoids, extracted oleoresins or synthetic aromatics) combined with added diluents or carriers such as vegetable oil, dextrose or starch.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 3302.10.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 1% ad valorem.

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
