

DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"PUREDELIVERY (TM) EVERFRESH 100 MILK CARAMEL FLAVOUR (BC-326-345-5)"

Based on the packing list, ingredient statement, manufacturing process flowchart, and sample submitted, subject article is a creamy-white, free-flowing powder composed of corn maltodextrin, natural flavouring substance, and modified waxy maize starch, among others. Packed in 20-kg fibreboard boxes, subject article is used as a flavor enhancer in the manufacture of cereal products.

REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Note 2 to Chapter 33 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 states that the expression "odoriferous substances" in heading 33.02 refers only to the substances of heading 33.01, to odoriferous constituents isolated from those substances or to synthetic aromatics.

Heading 33.02 of the AHTN 2017 covers, among others, mixtures of odoriferous substances and mixtures (including alcoholic solutions) with a basis of one or more of these substances, of a kind used as raw materials in industry. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers, among others, mixtures of one or more odoriferous substances (essential oils, resinoids, extracted oleoresins or synthetic aromatics) combined with added diluents or carriers such as vegetable oil, dextrose or starch, provided they are of a kind used as raw materials in the perfumery, food or drink industries (e.g., in confectionery, food or drink flavourings) or in other industries (e.g., soap-making).

"COFFEE FLAVOR SD050439"

Based on the packing list, ingredient declaration, manufacturing process flowchart, and sample submitted, subject article is a flavouring preparation, in the form of beige powder with characteristic strong odour, composed of synthetic flavouring substances (synthetic aromatics), natural flavouring substances, natural flavouring complexes, and maltodextrin, among others. Packed in 20-kg fibreboard boxes, subject article is used as an ingredient in the manufacture of coffee mixes.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Note 2 to Chapter 33 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 states that the expression "odoriferous substances" in heading 33.02 refers only to the substances of heading 33.01, to odoriferous constituents isolated from those substances or to synthetic aromatics.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"SODIUM HEXAMETAPHOSPHATE"

Based on the packing list, manufacturing process flowchart, statement of product composition, and sample submitted, subject article is pure sodium hexametaphosphate in the form of white crystalline powder. Packed in 25-kg bags, subject article is used as an emulsifier in the manufacture of powdered milk.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Note 1(a) to Chapter 28 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomen clature (AHTN) 2017 states that except where the context otherwise requires, the headings of this Chapter apply only to separate chemical elements and separate chemically defined compounds, whether or not containing impurities.

Heading 28.35 of the AHTN 2017 covers, among others, polyphosphates, whether or not chemically defined. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that the most important phosphates and polyphosphates include sodium polyphosphates having a high degree of polymerisation. Some sodium polyphosphates are incorrectly called sodium metaphosphates. There are several linear sodium polyphosphates having a high degree of polymerisation ranging from a few dozen to a few hundred units. Although they generally occur as polymers having an unspecified degree of polymerisation, they remain in this heading. These include: the product incorrectly known as sodium hexametaphosphate (a polymeric mixture of formula ((NaPO₃)_n), also known as Graham's salt, which is a vitreous substance or white powder, soluble in water. In aqueous solution, this product sequesters the calcium and the magnesium contained in the water, hence its use as a water softener. Also used in the preparation of detergents and casein glues, to emulsify essential oils, in photography, in the manufacture of processed cheese, etc.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 2835.39.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 1% ad valorem and an ASEAN Trade In Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".
