4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"FM1818"

Based on the chemical composition statement, testing report, product data sheet, and safety information sheet submitted, subject article is an ethylene-butene copolymer resin, containing by weight less than 95% ethylene and more than 5% 1-butene, with antioxidant, anti-block, slip, and processing aid (PPA) additives. It is in the form of an odourless natural-coloured solid, with a melt flow index of 1.1 g/10 minutes at 190°C and a density of 918 kg/m³. Packed in 25-kg bags, subject article is used in lamination applications; in the manufacture of liquid packaging, food packaging, agriculture films, and multi-layer packaging films; and as an impact modifier.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Note 4 to Chapter 39 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 states that the expression "copolymers" covers all polymers in which no single monomer unit contributes 95% or more by weight to the total polymer content. For the purposes of this Chapter, except where the context otherwise requires, copolymers (including co-polycondensates, co-polyaddition products, block copolymers and graft copolymers) and polymer blends are to be classified in the heading covering polymers of that comonomer unit which predominates by weight over every other single comonomer unit.

Furthermore, Note 6 (b) to this Chapter states that in headings 39.01 to 39.14, the expression "primary forms" applies only to blocks of irregular shape, lumps, powders (including moulding powders), granules, flakes and similar bulk forms.

Heading 39.01 of the AHTN 2017 covers polymers of ethylene, in primary forms.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 3901.40.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to the submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
