SUBJECT: Observance of the National Disaster Resilience Month 2021

Executive Order Number 29 s. 2017 designates July of each year as the National Disaster Resilience Month throughout the country and mandates the conduct of activities relative to building of disaster resilience covering the four thematic areas: prevention and mitigation, preparedness, response and rehabilitation and recovery.

The observance emphasizes the importance of DRRM and the need to understand disaster risks, enhancing community disaster preparedness, strengthening risk governance, investing in disaster risk reduction (DRR), increasing DRR disaster advocacy programs, enhancing preparedness for effective response and to "Build Back Better" recovery, rehabilitation, and reconstruction. Also the month of July marks the start of the wet or typhoon season highlighting the need to prepare for the same.

This year, the NDRM is marked with the theme "Tamang Pamamahala't Kahandaan, Kaalaman at Pagtutulungan sa Sakuna at Pandemya'y Kalasag ng Bayan", to emphasize the important role of disaster risk governance and the collaboration of all Filipinos to overcome the challenges of this pandemic and to build a green and resilient normal.

In this regard, all member agencies and regional and local DRRM Councils are hereby enjoined to observe the NDRM this July 2021 and are highly encouraged to conduct activities relative to the same, and to participate and promote the following NDRRMC activities:
