 Attached is a copy of Note No. 37 dated 19 June 2018¹ from the General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China (GACC), with English translation, informing the Embassy that during border clearance, many Chinese companies were required to submit health certificates issued by Chinese authorities for the food additives exported from China.

For the Philippines, GACC identified Department of Health (DOH) as the government agency that required the submission of such certificates.

- GACC informs Post that China recently adjusted its regulatory measures for the export of food additives. <u>The former AQSIQ² removed 90 HS Codes for food additives from the</u> <u>Import and Export Products Catalogue. Effective 01 February 2018, Chinese authorities</u> <u>are not required to inspect and issue health certificates for these food additives.</u>
- Post requests the Department's kind assistance in disseminating the above information to the Department of Health, Bureaus of Immigration and Customs and other concerned agencies.

The Inspection and Quarantine Clearance Department Note No.38 of 2018

The Note Regarding Canceling the Issuance of Health Certificate for the Export of Chinese Products No Longer Subject to China's Statutory Inspections

(The English Translation for reference)

The General Administration of Customs of the People's Republic of China presents its complements to your esteemed Embassy (Mission).

Recently, many Chinese companies have responded that during border clearance in your country the relevant agencies (see Annex 1) require the submission of Health Certificates issued by Chinese authorities for food additives exported from China. China's recent regulatory measures for the export of food additives have been adjusted and no official certificates have been issued for the export of the food additives which has no long been subject to statutory inspections in China. Now the relevant issues are explained as follows:

I. In accordance with the Announcement issued by the former General Administration of Quality Supervision, Inspection and Quarantine (AQSIQ) and the General Administration of Customs of P. R. China (GACC) with regard to the Adjustment of the Catalogue for the Import and Export Products Subject to China's Statutory Inspections and Quarantine (the former AQSIQ Announcement No. 21 of 2018), the former AQSIQ has removed the food additives of 90 HS Codes (see Annex 2) from the catalogue and has no longer carried out inspection and quarantine on these products since February 1, 2018. The former inspection and quarantine agencies have no longer issued official certificate for these food additives accordingly.

II. The First Session of the 13th National People's Congress of the People's Republic of China reviewed and approved the State Council's institutional reform scheme. Since April 20th, 2018, "the duties and teams of the former AQSIQ have been assigned to the GACC." The GACC is responsible for the subversion on the import and export of foods, food additives and food-related products.

III. We would like to kindly ask your Embassy to refer the above information to the relevant authorities in your country to ensure the smooth clearance of these goods and promote the stable development of bilateral trade.

近日,接中国多家企业反映,贵国相关机构(见附件1) 要求中国出口的食品添加剂需在贵国通关时提交中国官方 机构出具的健康证书。中国近期对出口食品添加剂管理措施 已调整,不再为中国法定检验以外的出口食品添加剂出具官 方证书。现就相关事宜做如下说明:

一、根据《质检总局海关总署关于〈出入境检验检疫机构实施检验检疫的进出境商品目录(2018)〉调整的公告》 (原质检总局公告2018年第21号),原国家质检总局将涉及90个海关商品编码的食品添加剂(见附件2)调出法检目录,自2018年2月1日起不再对其实施出境检验检疫。原检验检疫机构不再为出口食品添加剂出具官方证书。

二、中华人民共和国十三届全国人大一次会议审议通过 了国务院机构改革方案。自2018年4月20日起"国家质量 监督检验检疫总局的出入境检验检疫管理职责和队伍划入 海关总署"。海关负责对进出口食品、食品添加剂、食品相
