EMB-DTI'S ADOPTION OF AN ELECTRONIC SUBMISSION AND

APPROVAL OF COFFEE EXPORT CLEARANCE (CEC) AND

**CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPTION (COE)** 

Attached herewith is the letter of DTI-EMB Director Perlada providing information on the transitioning to online processing of its frontline services in compliance to stringent physical distancing measures to address COVID-19. This is also in line with the DTI's initiative anchored on the Ease of Doing Business and Efficient Government Service Act of 2018, where automation of frontline services is aimed at streamlining procedures to reduce processing time in securing permits and licenses for business related transaction through a zero-contact policy.


The Coffee Export Clearance (CEC) and Certificate of Exemption (COE) are coffee export documentation services of DTI-Export Marketing Bureau (DTI-EMB), in accordance with Chapter XII, Article 32-33 of the International Coffee Agreement (ICA) to which the Philippines is a member-country, will be streamlined through digitalization. In this regard, starting 13 July 2020, the EMB shall adopt an electronic submission and approval of CEC and COE.

The Clearance and Certificate will have a Digital Signature and Timestamp of the processor as security measure and emailed to clients in a Portable Document Format (.pdf). To this effect, document veracity audits may be freely conducted by your District in coordination with the Approving Officer.

# Coffee Export Clearance (CEC) Online Processing & Issuance

Requirements (scanned copies, to be submitted via email):

1. Accomplished Export Declaration Form

For seafreight, obtain ED using the website of VASP of E2M system (ekonek, cdec, and intercommerce); and for airfreight, proceed to One-Stop Export Documentation Center (OSEDC) of PHILEXPORT and fill-out manually an ED.

2. Proforma Bill of Lading

Airfreight or Sea freight booking of the cargo.

3. Commercial Invoice

Sales receipt with details of the export transaction.

4. Packing List

Packaging details of the cargo consistent with the commercial invoice.

### Process:

Exporter submits <u>scanned</u> copy of the original requirements in *.pdf* format, through email, to: <u>embcoffee@dti.gov.ph</u>.

Please note that our email server can only accommodate attachments up to a maximum of 20MB per message. You may opt to compress the file size of your documents without compromising readability.

- 1. Processor acknowledges receipt of document via email and proceed to evaluation of the application.
  - > If there are lacking requirements or details that need clarification, clients will be notified via email.
- 2. Submission of Incomplete requirements will not be processed.
- 3. Once application is approved, copy of the application will be sent back to the client via email with electronic Coffee Export Clearance (e-CEC) e-stamped (SeeAnnex 1) on the face of the ED in .pdf format.

### Online Processing & Issuance

Requirements (scanned copies, to be submitted via email):

- Original copy of Letter of Intent (to mention the coffee form, volume, and the contact details of the consignee)
- 2. Original copy of Proof or information to support the request for exemption.
- 3. Photocopy of the applicant's Company Identification (ID) Card or any government issued ID.

### Process:

Exporter submits <u>scanned</u> copy of the original requirements in .pdf format, through email, to: <u>embcoffee@dti.gov.ph</u>.

Please note that our email server can only accommodate attachments up to a maximum of 20MB per message. You may opt to compress the file size of your documents without compromising readability.

- 1. Processor acknowledges receipt of document via email and proceed to evaluation of the application.
  - > If there are lacking requirements or details that need clarification, clients will be notified via email.
- 2. Submission of Incomplete requirements will not be processed.
- 3. Once application is approved, copy of the application will be sent back to the client via email together with electronic Certificate of Exemption in .pdf format. (See Annex 2)
