This has reference to the request of our SRA Registered International Sugar Traders in good standing to expedite the release of their imported sugar, in line with our agency's importation program as stated in Sugar Order # 10 Series of 2017-2018 due to tightness of supply and price affordability.

We were informed that some traders are experiencing delays in securing License to Operate (LTO) and Certificate of Product Registration (CPR) from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

In connection with this, we would like to request on their behalf to facilitate their request in order to fast track the release of their importation since their sugar is being assessed in the BOC. These trader-importers are willing to execute an undertaking as commitment to comply and submit all the necessary documents as soon as they are available from the FDA.

We are providing you a list of registered international sugar trader for Crop Year 2017-2018 with import allocation (**copy attached**). The said list of international sugar traders are allowed to import sugar and a Clearance for Release of Imported Sugar is issued following the requirements for the subject importation.
