RAW MATERIALS THAT CAN BE USED IN COSMETIC PRODUCTS AND PERSONAL CARE RELATED PRODUCTS

Attached is the letter dated February 4, 2022 from Engr. Ana Trinidad F. Rivera, MSc, Director IV, Center for Cosmetics and Household/Urban Hazardous Substances Regulation and Research (CCHUHSRR), Food and Drug Administration (FDA) informing the Bureau that the importation of raw materials listed in the attached summary list and consigned to Euro Chemicals Inc. can be used in cosmetic products and personal care related products.

The information confirms that the following provision under FDA Memorandum Circular 2013-032 will prevail:

"For raw materials used in the manufacture of cosmetics and household and urban hazardous substances both the License to Operate (LTO) and the Certificate of Notification/ Registration are no longer required to be presented or submitted to the Bureau of Customs".
