AMENDMENT TO CMO 10-2021 ON WORKING HOURS RE: INTERNAL ADMINISTRATION MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (IAMS)

IMPLEMENTATION

In the interest of service and in connection with the implementation of the Internal Administration Management System (IAMS) in the Bureau, Item 1.8 of Customs Memorandum Order No. 10-2021 on Working Hours is hereby amended to read as follows:

1.8 Only the Commissioner, Deputy Commissioners, Service Directors, and Collector of Customs VI, who are presidential appointees, shall be exempt from logging in the biometric devices for attendance recording, but their attendance and leave of absences shall be reflected in their Daily Time Records.

Other provisions of CMO No. 10-2021 not affected by this Order shall remain in force and effect.
