It has been noticed that the AOMS data show numerous pending and open "AGEING" Alert Orders that have been stagnant since the time of alert issuance. Relative to this, you are hereby instructed to designate a responsible officer to head your alert monitoring unit to monitor all issued alert orders and to take a proactive policy for the immediate finalization of the alert issue.

A weekly report should be submitted to the Office of the Commissioner NLT than 1500H of the last working day of the week to include the latest status of all pending/open Alerted Shipments as well as the Actions taken during the week in a table format as seen below;
