
Call for Nominations for the 2022 Gawad Career

- The Career Executive Service Board (CESB) announced the opening of the nomination period to the 2022 Gawad Career Executive Service (Gawad CES), which is the annual Presidential award aims to recognize members in the CES for exemplary performance and significant contributions, particularly in the areas of innovation, information and communication technology, social services, administrative reforms, and public policy (attached Annex "A").
- 2. Relative thereto, the subject Presidential award is open to all Career Executive Service Officers (CESOs) and Third-level Eligibles (CEOE/CSEE/CESE) occupying executive and managerial position in the third level, who may either be nominated as an individual or as a group/team with maximum of ten (10) members who contributed to a common project outcome/output and has the following qualifications:
  - Must have at least Very Satisfactory performance rating equivalent for the last two (2) consecutive years prior to his/her/their nomination;
  - Should have never been found guilty of any administrative or criminal offense; and
  - c. Have not been formally charged administratively or criminally at the time of nomination.
- In this regard, nominators shall submit the following to the Human Resource Management Division not later than May 20, 2022 and a soft copy to the hrmd@customs.gov.ph, for further evaluation and endorsement to CESB:
  - a. nomination letter;
  - b. nomination form; and
  - c. Curriculum Vitaè of the nominee/s

## WHO CAN BE NOMINATED FOR THE CAMAD CEST

GAWAD CES is open to all Career Executive Service Officers (CESOs) and Third-Level Eligibles managerial positions in the third level, who may either be nominated as an individual or as a group/team with a maximum of ten (10) members who contributed to a occupying executive common project outcome/output. - \* Inter-agency the contributions must be implemented in various agencies and have brought beneficial results to the agencies or to a particular
- \* Intra-agency the contributions have made a positive difference within a particular agency.

In addition, he/she/they should have never considered contrary to community standards of justice, murder, rape, sexual harassment, embezzlement, honesty, or good morals i.e. graft and corruption, forgery, extortion, perjury, et al, and have not been ime of nomination.

# WHO CAN NOMINATES

Nominators for the GAWAD CES may be any of the following persons/organizations: Government agencies, national and regional their Heads of Offices or Chief Executive Officers; and associations of careerexecutive officers and non-government/civil society organizations, through

\* Nominee's superior/subordinate or any individual from the nominee's agency who has substantial knowledge of the nominee's leadership/managerial attributes and accomplishments.

officials, attaching the accomplished nomination form (downloadable at www.cesboard.gov.ph). A copy of A nominator can write to the Career Executive Service Board to nominate a qualified official/group of the Curriculum Vitae of the nominee/s should also be submitted before the published deadline. Only candidates nominated in writing shall be considered. Self nominations are not accepted. There is no limit to the number of candidates to be nominated by a nominating organization/agency. Agencies are encouraged to adopt their own selection/nomination system. However, nominations not subjected to the agency selection system shall still be accepted by the CESB, if it meets the criteria set forth in the Guidelines.

The CESB Secretariat shall conduct a pre-screening to ensure adherence to criteria and completion of documents. The Committee on Awards private/non-government sector, three (3) members of the CES Governing Board, and four (4) selected CES Officials shall be constituted to select the nominees who will undergo an in-depth validation and eventually composed of four (4) luminaries the year's GAWAD CES awardees.
