In line with the Bureau of Customs commitment to implement the Rules of Origin (ROO) of various Free Trade Agreements (FTAs) to which the Philippines is a party, all ports are hereby directed to submit at least five (5) original copies of updated customary signatures and initials of the respective Customs Officers authorized to issue and sign Certificates of Origin together with the specimen of the BOC Official Seal on or before 23 December 2022.

Prior to the said submission, you are also directed to submit to ECD, AOCG the advance copy of the said specimen signatures through ecd@customs.gov.ph within five (5) days from receipt hereof.

The list of authorized signatories and seal shall be transmitted to other member states and shall take effect on 02 January 2023.
