



4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"ZAMSTAT 120 (SALINOMYCIN SODIUM)"

Based on the unit dose and batch formulation, safety data sheet, product specifications, Certificate of Product Registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), product label, and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is an anticoccidial feed ingredient in the form of light-yellow to light-brown granules. It is composed of salinomycin sodium as active ingredient, with calcium carbonate as carrier. Packed in 25-kg bags, subject article is to be premixed with 10-20 kg of feeds before thoroughly mixed with the bulk feed, to obtain a concentration of 60 mg of salinomycin sodium. It is indicated for the prevention and control of coccidiosis caused by *Eimeria spp.* in poultry.

Based on the unit dose, batch formulation, product composition, safety data sheet, product specifications, Certificate of Product Registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), product label, and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is an antibacterial/anti-infective feed premix powder in the form of light-brown or tan granules with a characteristic odour. It is composed of zinc bacitracin as active ingredient, with corn starch and calcium carbonate as carriers. It is used for the prevention and treatment of necrotic enteritis in broilers and layers and for the control of swine dysentery associated with *Brachyspira hyodysenteriae* and clostridial enteritis caused by *C. perfringens* in pigs. Packed in 25-kg bags, subject article is premixed with 10 to 20 kg of feeds then thoroughly mixed with the bulk feed to obtain a level of 0.5 to 2 kg per ton of feed.

"ZAMIDINE 100 (ROBENIDINE HYDROCHLORIDE)"

Based on the unit dose and batch formulation, safety data sheet, product specifications, Certificate of Product Registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), product label, and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is an anticoccidial feed ingredient in the form of a white to off-white granular powder. It is composed of 100g/kg robenidine hydrochloride as active ingredient, with calcium carbonate as carrier. Packed in 25-kg bags, subject article is to be premixed with 10-20 kg of feeds before being thoroughly mixed with the bulk feed, to obtain a concentration of 35-50 mg robenidine hydrochloride per kilogram of feed. It is indicated for the prevention and control of coccidiosis caused by *Eimeria spp.* in poultry.

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"ZAMAX (MADURAMICIN AMMONIUM + NICARBAZIN)"

Based on the unit dose and formulation, Certificate of Product Registration from the Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI), safety data sheet, product specifications, product label, and photograph of the product submitted, subject article is an anticoccidial feed ingredient containing maduramicin ammonium and nicarbazin as active ingredients. It is in the form of a light yellow to brown powder. Packed in 25-kg bags, subject article is to be premixed with 10-20 kg of feeds before being thoroughly mixed with the bulk feed, to obtain a concentration of 3.75 mg maduramicin ammonium and 40 mg nicarbazin per kilogram of feed. It is indicated for the prevention and control of coccidiosis in broiler chickens caused by *Eimeria acervulina*, *Eimeria maxima*, *Eimeria tenella*, *Eimeria necatrix*, *Eimeria brunetti*, and *Eimeria mivati*.
