DECREE OF ABANDONMENT

WHEREAS, a shipment of 1x20' container bearing Container Van No. UETU2747532 said to contain Plastic Accessories, arrived at the Port of Manila on December 23, 2019, under Bill of Lading No. SITGDLMS950930 and consigned to **TYO SOLAR PANEL TRADING**;

WHEREAS, the District Collector, this Port, posted a Notice of Abandonment at the Website of the Bureau of Customs on April 21, 2021, since the consignee do not have any registered e-mail address to send the notice;

WHEREAS, the consignee was given fifteen (15) days from discharge of the last package from the vessel to file the goods declaration pursuant to Customs Administrative Order (CAO) No. 13-2020. However, despite due notice, no goods declaration was filed by the same. Further, the consignee did not file a request for extension of time to file good declaration pursuant to Section 407 of the CMTA which at the very least would show that they are still interested to claim their shipment.

WHEREAS, we find the foregoing as an abandonment of the consignee's proprietary rights over the shipment for its failure to claim the same despite due notice. Thus, the shipment is impliedly abandoned pursuant to CAO 13-2020 and Section 1129 of the CMTA, that specifically provides, to wit:

"Section 5. Impliedly Abandoned Goods. The following goods are considered impliedly abandoned:

5.1. Failure to Lodge/File the Goods Declaration after the lapse of the original fifteen (15) calendar days or as adjusted by the Commissioner, from the Date of Discharge of the Last Package;

"Section 1129. Abandonment, Kinds and Effects of. – Imported goods are deemed abandoned under any of the following circumstances;

" a) xxxx;

b) when the owner, importer, consignee, or interested party after due notice, falls to file goods declaration within the prescribed period in Section 407 of this Act; Provided, That the term goods declaration shall include provisional or incomplete goods declaration deemed valid by the Bureau as provided, in Section 403 of this Act. For this purpose, it is the duty of the District Collector to post a list of all packages

discharged and their consignees, whether electronically or physically in the District Office, or send a notice to the consignee within five (5) days from the date of discharge; or

WHEREFORE, in view of the foregoing, the above-mentioned shipment is hereby declared **ABANDONED** pursuant to CAO 13-2020 and Section 1129 (b) of the CMTA.

Let copies of this Decree of Abandonment be furnished to all parties and offices concerned for their information and guidance.
