SUBJECT: Acceptance of Paper Permits for Customs Clearance

Due to the continuous degradation in the performance of the National Single Window (NSW) System, the Bureau of Customs is temporarily accepting/ recognizing paper or manually-processed commodity clearances and permits while the NSW is undergoing corrective maintenance. Verification of such permits and licenses shall be done by the Customs Examiners, in coordination with the concerned regulating agencies. Further, concerned Bureau personnel are hereby directed to accept/recognize the manually-processed permits until the maintenance has been fully completed.

Meanwhile, processing of permits in the NSW System will still be continued while maintenance is ongoing.
