RE : **VALUE VERIFICATION OF AUTOMOBILES**

DATE : **May 30, 2014**

1. Effective 16 June 2014, you are hereby directed to refer to the Imports & Assessment Service (IAS) all entries of shipments covering completely built automobiles with AHTN Headings 87.02 & 87.03 that are propelled by gasoline, diesel, electricity, or any other motive power with engine displacement of 2,000 cc and above.
2. No release of shipments of automobiles under these tariff headings should be made without prior clearance from IAS.
3. The Import Assessment Service (IAS) will provide value recommendations to the Formal Entry Division (FED) or equivalent units.
4. **Exclusions from coverage of this Memorandum Circular:** This order excludes the following:
 - a. automobile shipments of Chamber of Automotive Manufacturers of the Philippines Incorporated (CAMPI) and Association of Vehicle Importers and Distributors (AVID) members.
 - b. all shipments of buses, trucks, cargo vans, jeepneys/jeepney substitutes, single cab chassis, and special purpose vehicles.
5. Proofs of Payment submitted shall be subjected to post-entry audit and verification with our commercial trade attaché in the country of origin.
6. For strict compliance.
