The 2015 Search for Outstanding Public Officials and Employees officially commenced with the issuance of Civil Service Commission Memorandum Circular No. 28, s. 2014.

The Honor Awards Program (HAP) covers all officials and employees in the career and non-career service of the government. Posthumous nominations may be made for a public servant who died in line of duty or in the pursuit of his/her official duties and responsibilities as a civil servant. Such nominations should be formalized within 12 months from the time of death of the official and/or employee.

Abueva • Cash reward worth P200,000.00 • Automatic promotion to the next higher position suitable to qualification with commensurate salary increase
