Dear Commissioner Mison:

This has reference to the following recommendations of the working group composed of the Tariff Commission, the National Statistical Coordinating Board and the National Statistics Office formed to discuss the monitoring of ASEAN PTA import statistics which were adopted by the Philippine Council for ASEAN Cooperation - Technical Board for ASEAN Economic Cooperation during its meeting on 15 November 1989:

1. That the Bureau of Customs be requested to require importers availing of Margin of Preference (MOP) under the ASEAN Preferential Trading Arrangement (PTA) to file another copy (fourth copy) of the Certificate of Origin Form C beginning 1 January 1990. The fourth copy of the Certificate of Origin should be properly numbered and be attached to the import entry that goes to the NSO which will henceforth prepare the import statistics on the availment of MOP's under the ASEAN PTA.
2. That the Bureau of Customs be requested to issue a Customs Memorandum Circular to enforce the proposed new requirement for circulation to all ports and sub-ports.
3. The National Statistics Office will compile the data for 1988 and 1989 while the Tariff Commission will prepare those for 1986 and 1987. Deadline for submission of data was set for end-December 1989 in time for the next COTT Meeting to be held in Cebu from 27 February to 1 March 1990.

In this regard, we would like to request the BOC to take appropriate implementing actions on the above recommendations.
