WHEREAS, the above-mentioned shipment arrived at the Port of Cebu on 05 January 2018, and process under Customs Import Entry No. C-821-18;

WHEREAS, the subject shipment was issued an Alert Order by the District Collector, this Port, with reference no. CE-0005-01102018;

WHEREAS, the shipment was examined on January 11, 2018 by Customs Examiner COO III M.R. Abella, together with representatives from the CIIS, ESS, District Collector's Office, and the shipper. As per the Alert Order Report Form, Customs Examiner COO III M. Abella indicated that the goods were found as declared:

WHEREAS, when the shipment was subjected to Magna Scale, it was found that there was a gross misdeclaration as to weight. It was declared that the shipment was only 115, 000 Kgs., but was found to weigh 148, 725 Kgs.

WHEREAS, the gross misdeclaration as to the weigh resulted to a 59.36% clifference between the declared and actual duties and taxes;

WHEREAS, pursuant to 1400 of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act, a discrepancy in duty and tax to be paid between what is legally determined and what is declared amounting to more than thirty (30%) percent shall constitute a prima facie evidence of fraud.



WARRANT OF SEIZURE AND DETENTION

To: The District Commander ESS-CPD, Port of Cebu

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned articles arrived via Mandaue Express Mail Hub, Foreign Parcel Unit, Port of Cebu from Taiwan on 27 April 2018;

WHEREAS, on 27 April 2018 at around 2:00 o'clock in the afternoon, 100% examination was conducted by the Assigned Examiner Erwin C. Andaya witnessed by representatives coming from Bureau of Animal Industry, Plant Quarantine, Philphost, Consignee and CIIS;

WHEREAS, after the examination, the importation was found to contain 10 pieces of live baby monitor lizards, 6 pieces of packed noodles; 2 boxes of rosquillos and 17 pieces of biscuits contrary to the declaration which is "kids product";

WHEREAS, the importation is in violation of Section 118 and Section 1113 par (f), (i), (j) and I (3, 4 & 5) of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act in relation to R.A. 9147;


