## **Basic Guidelines:**

- Filing of Bidder's Registration Form, submission of valid government-issued identification, clearance or registration from
  the concerned government agencies (in case of regulated goods) and registration on the logbook for bidders indicating
  the name, address and TIN and submission of proof of authority to represent principal (e.g. Special Power of
  Attorney/Board Resolution) for the specific auction sale, shall be on or before July 08, 2020 from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM,
  thereafter the registration shall be closed.
- 2. Payment of non-refundable Php 5,050.00 Registration Fee and Legal Research Fee.
- 3. Posting of a duly receipted bond in cash or manager's check in an amount equivalent to:

The Bond shall be refunded to the losing bidder after the closing of the auction.

- 5. The auction shall be conducted through sealed bids which shall be submitted and opened in public by the Auction Committee at the time, date, and place specified in the Notice of Public Auction.
- 6. The highest bid shall be declared the winner except when clustering occurs, that is, when the difference between the highest and the second highest bid is within ten percent (10%) of the highest bid. In such case, an open bidding shall be conducted among the bidders of a particular sale lot, who are present, with the highest bid serving as the new floor price. Only bids raised by three percent (3%) more than the new floor price shall be considered and the highest bid in the open-bidding shall be declared as the winner. Otherwise, the highest sealed bid shall be declared the winner.
- 7. At the end of each bidding, the highest bidder shall be required to surrender his acknowledgement receipt. Upon announcement of the winning bid, the winning bidder shall pay the bid price less the bond posted. Failure to pay the balance by the winning bidder shall cause the forfeiture of the deposit without prejudice to any sanction that the Committee may impose.

In case such payment has not been made, the subject Goods shall be re-offered within three (3) working days for Non-Perishable Goods and the next working day for Perishable Goods, unless the Commissioner provides a different period and subject further to compliance with the publication requirements of CAO 03-2020.

- 8. Payments with cashier's or manager's check must:
  - a. Pay to the order of the Bureau of Customs, Port of Clark
  - b. For the account of the winning bidder
- 9. A failed bidding shall be declared when any of the following circumstances occurs:
  - a. When there is no bid;
  - b. When the highest bidder fails to comply with any of the payments required in Section 5.10 of CAO 03-2020, said bidder shall be disqualified from participating further in the public auction and when applicable, the negotiated sale involving the same, without prejudice to the forfeiture of the minimum deposit and any payment made and imposition of other sanctions as may be warranted.
- 10. Non-compliance with any of the terms and conditions of the Notice of Public Auction shall result in the forfeiture of any payments made by the winning bidder without prejudice to the forfeiture of the subject shipments in favor of the Government.
- 11. The Bureau of Customs, District Port of Clark, reserves the right to ensure that only those who have complied with the requirements shall register and participate in the public sale.
