The European Union (EU) Directorate-General for Maritime Affairs and Fisheries (DG-MARE) is conducting an audit on June 3-6, 2014, to assess the Philippines' compliance to address illegal, unreported, and unregulated fishing (IUUF) as a requirement for continuous market access of our fish and fishery products to EU.

In line with this, we are respectfully inviting you and the District Collectors of the ports of General Santos City, Zamboanga City, NAIA and MICP to meet with the DG-MARE team on **June 4, 2014, 9:00 AM to 12:30 PM** at **BFAR Conference Room**, 3rd Floor, PCA Main Building, Elliptical Road, Diliman, Quezon City as specifically requested by the EU DG-MARE. The presence of high-level officials would indicate the importance given by government to addressing the IUUF concerns of our market. It is imperative that we be able to answer all the issues raised by DG-MARE specifically on traceability of fish and fishery products in the ports of General Santos City, Zamboanga City, NAIA and MICP to prevent the yellow tagging or pre-identification of the Philippines as a non cooperating state by the EU. We likewise request that customs data and other relevant documents that would be needed by DG-MARE be brought to the meeting.
