Terms and Conditions of Public Auction:

1. Who may participate:
 - a) Individual –Submission of two valid government IDs and latest Income Tax Return, whenever applicable
 - b) Sole Proprietorship
 - c) Partnership/Corporation
2. The conduct of Public of Auction on the given date shall be subject to further conditions in the observance of the Alert Level 1 Quarantine Status, to wit;
 - a. Only one representative per qualified bidder for crowd control;
 - b. Qualified bidders shall strictly observe the prescribed rules on physical distancing;
 - c. Wearing of face mask and face shield shall be required.
 - d. Body temperature of the qualified bidders shall be screened
 - f. Bidders will stay in the BTr Cafeteria area after registration. There will be a camera feed in the area for the Auction Committee to monitor.
 - g. Bidders for a certain auction lot under consideration shall proceed to the Marble Hall to bid and await results therein.

3. Filing of Bidder's Registration Form (with name, address, and TIN), together with the latest certified true copy of Income and/or Business Tax Returns duly stamped and received by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) with a validated tax payment made thereon at least two (2) days prior to the day of auction at the Office of the Auction and Cargo Disposal Division, MICP.
4. Payment of non-refundable Php5,050.00 Registration Fee. Such payment shall be accepted **ONLY** upon submission of the covering **Special Power of Attorney** or **Secretary's Certificate**, as the case maybe, **specifically** authorizing the purported representative to participate in the Public Auction.
5. Registration on the logbook for registered bidders indicating the name, address, and TIN to be made with the Chief, ACDD one (1) day before the date of actual bidding until exactly an hour immediately preceding the time of actual bidding; thereafter registration is closed.
6. Posting of duly receipted bond in cash or, manager's check in the amount equivalent as stated in CAO No. 04-2016 (please refer to the table below for the bond). The bond shall be refunded to the losing bidder after the closing of the auction.

7. The Payment of highest bidder in cash or manager's check at least fifty percent (50%) of the bid price on the spot upon announcement of the winning bid as duly certified to by the Inter-Agency Auction Committee and the COA representative. The remaining balance of 50% shall be paid on the succeeding business day.
8. Payments with Cashier's/ Manager's Check/ Cash to the BOC/ MICP shall bear the following:
 - a. Pay to the Order of BOC MICP FAO ____;
 - b. For credit of the Bureau of Customs _____;
 - c. For the account of: _____ (Bidder) _____;
9. The auction shall be conducted through hybrid submission of bids. The qualified bidder shall fill up an electronic bid tender form at the auction venue. The electronic form will be accessed securely in a computer onsite. The entries made in the form will be tabulated in an array that will be visible to all participating parties.

No manual entries will be made in the array unless there are discrepancies identified by the Auction Committee.

In this regard, bidders will still need to manually accomplish the bid tender form in writing to create a basis to verify if what the bidder has entered electronically is accurate or not. In case of discrepancy, the manual bid form prevails.

10. The highest bid shall be declared as the winner except when clustering occurs. Clustering occurs when the difference between the highest and the second highest bid is within ten percent (10%) of the highest bid. In such case, an open-bidding shall be conducted among the bidders of the particular sale lot who are present with the highest bid serving as the new floor price. Only bids raised by three percent (3%) more than the new floor price shall be considered and the highest bid in the open-bidding shall be declared as the winner. Otherwise, the highest sealed bid shall be declared as the winner.
11. In case there is a tie for the highest bid, the subject item or lot shall be subjected to another hybrid submission of bids again among the tied bidders. In case of another tie, the winner shall be determined by toss coin.
12. A failed bidding shall be declared by the Inter- Agency Auction Committee when any of the following circumstances occurs:
 - a. When there is only one who submitted a bid, the same shall not be opened;
 - b. When there are two submitted bids but there is only one bid higher than the floor price;
 - c. When the highest bidder fails to comply with any of the payments required under section 7 thereof, said bidder shall be disqualified from participating further in the auction sale and when applicable, the negotiated sale thereof without prejudice to the forfeiture of the cash bond and any payment made and imposition of other sanctions as may be warranted.
13. When a failed bidding is declared, the item of the sale lot shall be re-offered after five (5) calendar days upon publication in the official website and/or social media page of the of the participating agencies and posting in a conspicuous place of the Bureau of Customs.
14. When the winning bidder fails to claim the items or lots awarded to him within ten (10) calendar days from the date of award, upon due notice, he shall be deemed to have abandoned said goods and to have renounced all his rights thereto including forfeiture of all payments made thereon, except upon justifiable reasons, as determined by the Chairman, upon recommendation of the Inter-Agency Auction Committee.
15. Non-compliance with any of the terms and conditions of the Notice of Public Auction shall result in the forfeiture of any payments made by the winning bidder without prejudice to the forfeiture of the subject shipments in favor of the Government.
16. Release of subject luxury vehicles shall be supervised by ACDD, ESS, POS, OCOM, CIIS, IG, ODC and COA representatives.
