4 DESCRIPTION

"SAMSUNG DA-E550 2:0 CHANNEL WIRELESS AUDIO DOCK"

Based on the brochure and user manual submitted, subject article is a horn-shaped audio dock with speaker on both ends. It has a pop out dual function cradle with a 5-pin connector for Samsung Galaxy devices and a 30-pin connector for Apple devices. The dock allows users to charge a device, while the loudspeakers allow users to play the music saved on the device. Its Bluetooth audio relay feature also enables subject article to play music stored on a computer or other portable devices. Its other specifications are:

Heading 85.18 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) Tariff and Customs Code covers, among others, loudspeakers, whether or not mounted in their enclosures. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes state that the function of loudspeakers is the converse of that of microphones: they reproduce sound by converting electrical variations or oscillations from an amplifier into mechanical vibrations which are communicated to the air.

In view thereof, subject article, functioning primarily as a loudspeaker, is classified under AHTN 2012 subheading 8518.22.90 of the Code with Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 10% ad valorem; and ASEAN-China Free Trade Area (ACFTA) and ASEAN-Korea Free Trade Area (AKFTA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificates of Origin (CO) "Form E" and "Form AK", respectively.

Based on the prescribing information, certificate of product registration and sample submitted, subject article is an antibiotic containing amoxicillin and clavulanic acid. It is in the form of off-white powder with a fruity flavor soluble in water. Each 5mL of reconstituted suspension contains 125mg amoxicillin and 31.25mg clavulanic acid. Packed in 60mL clear glass bottle, it is used for the treatment of common bacterial infections where antibiotic therapy is indicated, including respiratory tract infections, osteomyelitis, septicemia, peritonitis, and post-operative infections.




