Pursuant to the provision of Section 1139 of the Customs Modernization and Tariff Act (CMTA) of the Philippines, in relation to CAO 10-2007, as amended by CAO 03-2020, and other relevant Customs Memorandum Orders, there will be a Public Auction Sale through Sealed Bidding to be conducted by the Auction and Cargo Disposal Division, Port of Cebu, on **21 December 2021 at 10:00 am** to be held at the Multi-Purpose Hall, Second Floor, Cebu Customs House. The goods shall be available for viewing within working hours prior to the day of the Public Auction, at the CIP Holding Area, Cebu City. In the event a failed bidding is declared, the item or sale lot shall be referred to the Committee on Negotiated Sale if applicable or re-offered after five (5) calendar days upon publication in the official website and/or social media page of the Bureau, and posting in a conspicuous place of the Port, or in case of perishable goods, the second auction shall be conducted after three (3) calendar days from posting.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR REGULATED SHIPMENTS:

- Pursuant to Section 5.6 of Customs Administrative Order No. 03-2020, persons interested to participate in the bidding of regulated goods must comply or present a Clearance or Registration from the concerned government agency.



- For Sale Lot Nos. 91-2021 and 92-2021: Interested bidders must be BAI Registered as “Commercial Only M” Feed Miller/ Mixed Feeds Manufacturer.
- Prior to the release of goods covered by the mandatory certification requirement, the winning bidder must apply, secure, and present the Certificate of Conditional Release from the Bureau of Philippine Standard (BPS) - Department of Trade and Industry (DTI), pending the issuance of the Import Commodity Clearance (ICC) from the BPS-DTI.

BASIC GUIDELINES:

1. Filing of the complete and duly notarized Registration Form (Port of Cebu Form) and registration in the logbook, shall only be accepted on **20 December 2021 between 8:00 am up to 5:00 pm**, which shall include but are not limited to the following required documents:
 - Original or Certified True Copy of the latest income Tax and/or business Tax Return duly stamped “RECEIVED” by the Bureau of Internal Revenue, with validated tax payment made on the latest Income Tax Return. (BIR Form 2303 if it is a new corporation)
 - Two (2) Government Identification Cards of the bidder and the authorized representative of the bidder.
2. If necessary, a Special Power of Attorney/ Notarized Partnership Resolution/ Board Resolution and Secretary’s Certificate authorizing the representative of the Bidder to act for and in behalf of the Bidder and to specifically perform the following acts:
 - to register the Bidder on **20 December 2021**,
 - to participate in the auction on **21 December 2021**, in the Port of Cebu
 - submit the necessary documents
 - post the necessary bond
 - to sign and execute documents
 - to bid and bind the Bidder
 - to tender payment
 - to receive documents on behalf of the Bidder
3. Any new, additional, supplemental, or remedial paper/ document shall no longer be accepted after the afore-mentioned deadline.
4. The Public Auction shall comply with all relevant laws, rules, and regulations.
5. The conduct of the Public Auction Sale shall be subject to the following safety measures:
 - Qualified bidders shall strictly observe social distancing

- Only the qualified bidder and one companion shall be allowed inside the designated place for the Public Auction
 - Wearing of face masks and face shields is mandatory.
 - Body temperature of all qualified bidders and their companions shall be screened.
 - All participants shall at all times maintain proper and professional decorum.
6. The Auction Committee by a vote of simple majority, may disqualify any bidder or companion from participating or attending in the Public Auction. The disqualified bidder or companion shall be removed from the premises.
 7. Payment of Php 5,000.00 Registration Fee, and legal research fee of Php 50.00. (non-refundable).
 8. Posting of a duly receipted bond upon registration shall be made no later than **20 December 2021 at 5:00 pm**, in cash or manager's check in an amount equivalent to:

Floor Price	Bond
Not Over Php 10,000.00	None
Over Php 10, 000.00 but not over Php 1, 000, 000.00	20%
Over Php 1, 000, 000.00 but not over Php 2, 500, 000.00	15%
Over Php 2, 500, 000.00 but not over Php 5, 000,000.00	10%
Over Php 5, 000,000.00	5%

9. At the end of the bidding, the highest bidder shall be required to pay on cash/ manager's check equivalent to fifty percent (50%) of the bid price "ON THE SPOT" upon announcement of the winning bid on top of the bond in cash or manager's check as required in the immediately preceding paragraph. The remaining balance shall be paid on the succeeding business day. Failure to make any of the payments as required shall disqualify the bidder from participating further in the auction sale and the negotiated sale thereof, if applicable. This is without prejudice to the forfeiture of the cash bond and other payments made and the imposition of other sanctions as may be warranted.
10. The auction shall be conducted through sealed bids, which shall be submitted and opened in public by the Auction Committee at a time, date and place specified in the Notice of Auction Sale.
11. The highest bid shall be declared as the winner except when clustering occurs. Clustering occurs when the difference between the highest and second highest bid is within the ten percent (10%) of the highest bid. In such case, an open bidding shall be conducted among the bidders of the particular sale lot who are present with the highest bid serving as the new floor price. Only bids raised by three percent (3%), more than the new floor price shall be considered and the highest bid in the open bidding shall be declared as the winner. Otherwise, the highest sealed bid shall be declared as the winner.

12. A failed bidding shall be declared by the Auction Committee when any of the following circumstances occurs:

- When there is only one sealed bid, the same shall not be opened.
- When there are two sealed bids but there is only one bid higher than the floor price.
- When there is no bid.
- When the highest bidder fails to comply with any of the payments required under Section 5.10 of CAO No. 03-2020, said bidder shall be disqualified from participating further in the public auction.

13. Clearances or Permits from the regulatory agency shall be required prior to the release of regulated goods, if applicable.

14. Payment with Manager's Check to the Bureau of Customs, District Port of Cebu (BOC, POC) shall bear:

a. Pay to: **BOC FAO Bidder Name.**


15. When the winning bidder fails to claim the items or lots awarded to him within thirty (30) calendar days from the date of award, upon DUE NOTICE, he shall be deemed to have abandoned said goods and to have renounced all his rights thereto including forfeiture of all payments made thereon, except upon justifiable reason, as determined by the District Collector, upon recommendation of the Auction Committee.

16. Non-compliance with any of the terms and conditions of the Notice of Public Auction or applicable laws, rules, and regulations shall result in the forfeiture of any payments made by the winning bidder without prejudice to the forfeiture of the subject shipments in favor of the government.

17. Finally, the herein terms and conditions of the Notice of Public Auction and all applicable laws, rules, and regulations shall be mandatory.
