Item 12.1 (a) Single Largest Contract	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A photocopy of the Single Largest Completed Contract must be submitted i.e. similar contract completed within the last five (5) years prior to December 8, 2014, whose value must be at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC supported by the Constructors Performance Evaluation System (CPES) rating sheet which must have a satisfactory rating or a certificate of satisfactory completion of the project. • Tax Clearance Certificate from the Bureau of Internal Revenue shall also be submitted as part of the eligibility and technical documents contained in the first envelope.

Item 12.1 (b)(ii.2)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The List of Contractor's personnel to be assigned to the Contract must be supported by their respective updated resumes, photocopy of Professional Regulations Commission (PRC) valid license, DPWH Accreditation and Occupational and Safety Certificate, if applicable. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Materials Engineer <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Valid PRC License - Updated resume - DPWH accreditation 2. Safety Officer <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Valid PRC License - Updated resume - Occupational and Safety Certificate

<p>C. Additional Scope of Work</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Include scope of work for the rehabilitation of structural columns, beams and slabs and non-destructive testing to verify the structural soundness and stability of the rehabilitated structure. • The contractor shall provide a certificate of non-destructive test, indicating that the rehabilitation made with the building structure is structurally sound, conducted by a separate private consultant who has the technical expertise and modern equipment.
