

This has reference to the letter-request dated August 18, 2017 of Ms. Michelle Navarro, Logistics Manager of EXITO ELECTRONICS COMPANY PHILS., INC. (hereinafter referred to as "EXITO ELECTRONICS," for brevity), to reconstruct the lost/misplaced Import Entry No. C81607-17 covering its shipment of 1x40' Container STC: Power Supply Cord which arrived at this Port on March 19, 2017 on board the vessel "ZIM Rotterdam," Voy. 040W covered by B/L No. MSP0016931A,

The shipment was imported and released from this Port free and exempt from payment of duties and taxes pursuant to Sec. 105 of the TCCP, as amended and is covered by the appropriate Exemption Certificate issued by the Department of Finance on March 8, 2017. Certificate of Exemption provides that EXITO ELECTRONICS shall post a Re-Export Bond equal to one and one-half (1-1/2) times the ascertained, duties, taxes and other charges due thereon to guarantee the reexportation thereof within six (6) months from date of acceptance of the import entry, or in default thereof, the payment of duties and taxes.

Accordingly, EXITO ELECTRONICS posted Re-Export Bond No. BD-C(9)HO-000000279 issued by the AFP GENERAL INSURANCE CORP. on March 30, 2017 in the principal amount of P2.5 Million.

On August 18, 2017, Ms. Michelle Navarro, Logistics Manager of EXITO ELECTRONICS, wrote a letter to the District Collector, this Port (Attention: The Chief, Law Division), requesting that it be allowed to reconstruct Import Entry No. C81607-17 which

lost/misplaced and could no longer be retrieved. Ms Navarro attached to her letter the sworn Affidavit of Loss executed by Mr. Michael Langcauon Ragodon, a Customs Representative of IVAN JOHN E. IGIG Customs Brokerage, wherein he alleged, among others, as follows:

- At around 4:00 p.m. of March 31, 2017, he borrowed from the Clerk of Section 4, Formal Entry Division, this Port, the original documents of Import Entry No. C81607-17, together with its attachments, for photocopying as office file.
- Mr. Ragodon averred further that he left the said documents for photocopying with the Photomachine Operator since the documents were voluminous, not to mention that there were also other clients waiting to be served.
- He went back to the Photomachine Operator at around 5:00 p.m., who handed him stacks of documents purporting to be the same documents he asked to be photocopied.
- To his dismay, however, the set of documents handed over to him did not include the original of Import Entry No. C81607-17 and its original attachments. He manifested that both he and the Photomachine Operator took pains and exerted serious efforts to locate and retrieve the said documents, to no avail.
- He thus took sole responsibility for the loss of the said documents and freely executed the said affidavit in order to support the request for reconstruction thereof.

Customs Memorandum Order (CMO) No. 15-2002 is explicit on the procedures and requirements bearing on reconstruction of lost import or other official documents, to wit:

> XXX X X X"x x x"

- 1. A written request for the reconstruction of lost import documents or other official documents shall be filed with the Office of the District Collector in the Port where the said documents were entered/filed, attaching therewith the following:
 - Affidavit of Loss of the person responsible (importer, broker's representative or Customs employee/custodian) for the loss of the import document(s) duly registered with the Law Division;
 - Verified photocopy of the lost import documents; duly certified document(s) by or on behalf of the importer/broker may be 1.2 accepted in lieu of the verified photocopy pursuant to Sec. 3515 of the TCCP, as amended;
 - Proposed reconstructed copy or copies of the lost import documents with the required amount of Customs 1.3

documentary stamps already affixed thereon; and

Print-out of the Temporary Assessment Notice and SAD covering the importation to be sourced from the Office of the 1.4 Chief, FED/WAD or equivalent unit in the Port.

xxx x x x x XXX

From the foregoing, and considering the faithful compliance with its foregoing conditions, this Office recommends the approval of the request of EXITO ELECTRONICS COMPANY PHILS., INC. to reconstruct Import Entry No. C81607-17 and its supporting documents for the purpose of final liquidation and cancellation of Re-Export Bond No. BD-C(9)HO-000000279 in the principal amount of P2.5 Million which it posted in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Certificate of Exemption for the duty and tax-free release thereof by the Department of Finance. It is apparent, too, EXITO ELECTRONICS COMPANY PHILS., INC. has no other recourse other than to reconstruct the said import entry since the retrieval thereof is no longer possible.

The approval of the instant request is conditioned upon the utilization thereof for the cancellation of the re-export bond which EXITO ELECTRONICS COMPANY PHILS., INC. posted for the release of its subject importations, and compliance with such other Customs laws, rules and regulations pertinent thereto.

AFFIDAVIT OF LOSS

I, MICHAEL LANGCAUON RAGODON, Filipino, of legal age and with postal address at Room 303A, 3rd Floor FUBC Building, Escolta, Manila after having duly sworn to in accordance with law, hereby depose and state:

- 1. I am an employee of Ivan John E. Igig Customs Brokerage as a Customs Representative.
- Last March 22, 2017 we received a shipping documents from our client Exito Electronics Company Philippines Inc.
- 3. The shipment is said to contain 904 cartons of power supply cords from US on a 1x40' container van.
- It's a return shipment from USA which was previously exported from Philippines last December 03, 2016 under BL number MNL0062394 and container number HLXU 5245461 via Zim Rotterdam 040W.
- 5. It was ordered by US Customs to be returned to its origin due to contamination (wild sugar cane flowers on the pallets).
- 6. We lodged the Import Entry last March 30,2017 resulting to entry number C-81607-17 under re-export bond per approved endorsement of the Department of Finance.
- Said shipment under Import Entry number C-81607-17 went through the normal and standard process of releasing an imported shipment.
- 8. On March 31, 2017, we have finished all Customs formalities and delivered the goods to the consignee.
- 9. On that same day, March 31, 2017 at around 4:00 pm, I borrowed the original documents of Import Entry Number C-81607-17 from Section 4 of the Formal Entry Division, Bureau of Customs, Manila International Container Port, North Harbor for photocopying as office file. I left the same to the photocopy machine operator for there was so many pages to be reproduced so with the numbers of clients waiting to be served. Then, I went for payment of arrastre charges. When I got back to pick up said documents, around of toopm, the operator handed a bunch of documents to me. When I checked, there were no originals. I asked the operator where the originals are, she said it was at the bunch of documents handed on to me. The operator and I have exerted efforts to look for the Import Entry number C-81607-17 but all our efforts have been in vain.
 - 10. I am thus taking responsibility and executing this Affidavit of Loss to attest that the original can no longer be found despite efforts to search for it.
 - 11. I am also executing this Affidavit of Loss for the purpose of assisting in the request for reconstruction of the said document and for whatever legal purpose it may serve.
