During the 2017 State of the Nation Address held at the Batasang Pambansa, Quezon City on 24 July 2017, the President emphasized the need to ensure disasterresiliency and effective response to the real and imminent threat of a major earthquake in the Greater Metro Manila Area, which is our country's seat of governance, center of business, commerce, and the academe. Disaster resiliency of Metro Manila and the surrounding provinces is a matter of urgent national concern.

Thus, he directed the Cabinet Cluster on Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation and Disaster Risk Reduction (CCAM-DRR) to immediately work with the concerned departments and agencies, local government units, the private sector, and affected communities in implementing disaster resiliency measures. The Cluster may build on the initial work and action plan crafted by a group of agencies composed of the OP-PMS, DILG, DPWH, MMDA, DOST-PHIVOLCS, and the NDRRMC-OCD, among others.

These measures may include the immediate retrofitting of all critical public and private infrastructure; and the setting-up of alternative Government command, control, and operations centers in each of the three island regions to ensure preparedness and continuity of government and business operations, among others.

Submit a status report of actions taken, citing the above reference number, to the Office of the Executive Secretary and the Office of the Cabinet Secretary at osec@cabsec.gov.ph, copy furnished the Presidential Management Staff at directives@pms.gov.ph not later than 15 days upon receipt of this memo, and regular updates thereafter until the directive has been fully complied with.
