- SUBJECT: Clarification on CMO 13-2016 on "Implementing the Provisions of CMO 43-2010 on the use of e2M Customs Systems for the Transfer of Containerized Sea Freight to Off-Dock CY/CFS and with Airfreight to Airport CBW Operators"

Following the implementation of CMO 13-2016 on the **implementation of Cargo Transfers from NAIA to Airport CBWs on June 16, 2016**, the following are hereby amended:

3.1.2 **Payment of the Transfer Fees**

Under Section 3.1.2.1, there is no need for Airport CBW Operators to put up a deposit in the Collection Division for the payment of the Transfer Fees because the boatnote form being used to transfer the goods, has been dispensed with by the posting of the General Transportation Surety Bond (GTSB) in Sec. 3.1.5.1.

3.1.4 **Approval of the Transit Permit Application**

Under Section 3.1.4.6, the Deputy Collector for Operations or it's authorized Representative shall approve the TP to be transferred by tagging "APPROVED" in the system. The approval of the Transit Permit is 24/7 from Monday to Sunday including Holidays.

All rules and regulations inconsistent with this Order/Clarification are hereby deemed, repealed, suspended or modified accordingly.

This order shall take effect upon implementation of the Transfer of Cargo from NAIA to Airport CBWs on June 16, 2016.
