# NATIONAL BLOOD CENTER -Manila VOLUNTARY BLOOD DONATION

## **QUALIFICATIONS AND REQUIREMENT:**

1 valid I.D.

Generally in good health condition

Age: 16-60 years old (16-17 needs guardian's written consent)

Weight: 110 lbs or 50 kgs and above

**Physical examination** will be assessed by prior to donation

### **REMINDERS BEFORE DONATION:**

- -Have enough rest and sleep, minimum of 5 hours
- -No alcohol intake 24 hours prior to blood donation
- Travel, taken medications, piercing and tattoos will be assessed on site.
- -Have something to eat prior to blood donation, avoid fatty foods.

#### AFTER BLOOD DONATION:

- -Drink plenty of fluids like water or juice.
- -Refrain from stooping down after blood donation.
- -Refrain from strenuous activities
- -If there is discoloration and swelling on the punctured site, you may apply cold compress for 24 hours and then hot compress for the next 24 hours.
- -If there is dizziness, just lie down on a flat surface with feet elevated.

## **APHERESIS DONATION**

Platelet pheresis donation of PRC is a specialized procedure which focuses on clients in need of PLATELETS (Dengue, cancer, etc.).

#### How does it happen?

While hooked on a machine, it separate donor's blood into red cells, plasma and platelets, harvests the platelets, and returns remaining components back to donor.

Initial screening of donor, including complete blood count with platelet count will be done prior to donation to qualify.
