SUBJECT: Shipments of Resin

DATE: 28 January 2016

- 1. This Memorandum amends OCOM Memorandum dated 26 November 2015 on the category of Resins only.
- 2. All import entries under the tariff headings provided in **Annex A**, with the declared value falling below the threshold value shall be released only if upgraded based on the threshold value or when the importer avails the remedy of Payment under Protest pursuant to Section 2308 of the Tariff and Customs Code of the Philippines.
- 3. The threshold values indicated in **Annex A** shall be updated on a periodic basis. Succeeding adjustments shall be issued by the Office of the Deputy Commissioner for Assessment and Operations Coordinating Group, with notice to the Office of the Commissioner.
- 4. Non-compliance by any customs official with any provision of this Memorandum will be an incidence of Simple Neglect of Duty as used in CMO 25-2010, Title IV, Section 2, and shall be punishable upon second offense by Dismissal.

This Memorandum shall take effect on February 1, 2016.

Dear Ms. Danofrata:

Submitted below to your esteemed office are the current plastics resins international prices and their comparison with the reference values under Memorandum Order issued by your good office dated 26 November 2015.

In view of the declining world crude oil price that may go lower than US\$30.00 per barrel, the international, prices of plastics resins as stipulated will proportionally go down to its lowest level.

Our industry therefore appeals to your good office that the current customs values used in the Memorandum Order be adjusted since they are already higher than the actual prevailing international market price. The market prices are expected to continuously go down in view of OPEC's oversupply which will further dip down with the additional influx of the oil supply with the lifting of the trade sanctions of Iran.

Another factor to consider is the avoidance of the use of fossil fuels by committed countries, in response to the recent worldwide clamor of further mitigating the problem of climate change and global warming.

Below is the comparison between the January 2016 resin prices and the values stipulated in the said Memorandum Order we appeal for its amendments.
