Your attention is invited to the letter dated 20 July 2017 of Atty. Marianne P. Lozada-Marquez, Duly Appointed Receiver of the Insurance Commission to the Bureau of Customs, re: Insurance Commission's issued Order against Philippine Fire and Marine Insurance Corporation to cease and desist from doing insurance business and simultaneously placing it under Receivership effective 03 July 2017.

In view thereof, you are hereby directed to immediately refer all available records/certified copies of issued bonds that have bearing on the indebtedness of various importers that were covered by Philippine Fire and Marine Insurance Corporation to the Legal Service, for the latter to take appropriate legal action against the principal obligors and to ensure that proper documentary evidence are collated and available for the filing of appropriate actions against the principal/importers and for inclusion in the BOC's claim against the surety company - placed under Receivership by the Insurance Commission.

Likewise, if the above-cited accounts have already been submitted to the Legal Service, RCMG, you are hereby advised to furnish this Office of the above-stated action.

IN THE MATTER OF RECEIVERSHIP OF PHILIPPINE FIRE AND MARINE INSURANCE CORPORATION

NOTICE OF STAY ORDER

On 17 July 2017, the Insurance Commission, by virtue of its powers and mandate under Republic Act No. 10607 (otherwise known as the Insurance Code of the Philippines, as amended) placed Philippine Fire and Marine Insurance Corporation (PFMIC) under Receivership. Atty. Marianne P. Lozada-Marquez was designated as Receiver of the Company on the same date.

Accordingly, pursuant to the powers of the Insurance Commission and the powers of the Receiver under Republic Act No. 10607, all payment of claims effective $\underline{l} \gamma$ July 2017, are stayed or suspended until further notice. Specifically:

- All actions or proceedings, in court or otherwise, for the enforcement of all claims, whether for money or otherwise, against PFMIC are suspended;
- b) PFMIC is prohibited from selling, encumbering, transferring or disposing in any manner whatsoever any of its properties except in the ordinary course of business and upon recommendation by the appointed Receiver of the company and/or the Conservatorship, Receivership and Liquidation (CRL) Division and approval of the Insurance Commissioner;
- c) Likewise, PFMIC is prohibited from making any payment of its liabilities as of 17–July 2017; and
- d) PFMIC is directed to pay in full all approved administrative expenses incurred after the date of the issuance of this stay order.

All policyholders, creditors and interested parties including those with pending cases in courts and similar bodies are directed to file and address their claims to the Insurance Commission, thru Atty. Marianne P. Lozada-Marquez at Insurance Commission,1071 United Nations Avenue, Manila, or at LEYNES LOZADA-MARQUEZ LAW OFFICES, 15th Floor, Petron Mega Plaza, 358 Sen. Gil Puyat Avenue,1200 Makati City, Metro Manila.

This Stay Order and its annexes shall be posted at the entrance or at a conspicuous place at the main and other offices of PFMIC. Further, the receiver is also directed to cause the immediate publication of this stay order in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines, once a week for three consecutive weeks, with first publication to be made within ten (10) days from the date hereof in accordance with Circular Letter No. 2016-34 dated 21 June 2016 on Newspaper Publication requirements.

Alternatively, this Stay Order may be viewed or downloaded from the website of the Insurance Commission at www.insurance.gov.ph. All interested parties are enjoined to visit the said website from time to time for other announcements.
