- c. Effect of the "No Sectioning Policy" to the implementation of the Lateral Attrition Law (**RCMG in coordination with AOCG, POM and MICP**)
- d. Prioritization of Sec. 108 of the CMTA on the imposition of penalties for errors in goods declaration (**RCMG in coordination with Project Management Office**)
- e. Monthly Performance Collection per Port (**RCMG in coordination with AOCG and Collection Districts**)
- f. Status of Alert Orders for the past three years (**IG in coordination with EG, AOCG and All Collection Districts**)
- g. Weekly Report starting December 18, 2017 on all Alert Orders (**IG in coordination with All Collection Districts**)
- h. Monthly Report on all administrative issuances of the BOC (**IAG**)
- i. Measures/actions taken by the BOC with regards to the recommendations made by the Committee concerning the P6.4 Billion Pesos SHABU apprehension last May 2017 (**RCMG in coordination with IAG**)
