Heading 23.09 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers preparations of a kind used in animal feeding. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers, among others, preparations for use in making the complete feeds or supplementary feeds. These preparations, known in trade as "premixes", are, generally speaking, compound compositions consisting of a number of substances (sometimes called additives) the nature and proportions of which vary according to the animal production required. These substances include, among others, those which improve digestion and, more generally, ensure that the animal makes good use of the feeds and safeguard its health: vitamins or provitamins, amino-acids, antibiotics, coccidiostats, trace elements, emulsifiers, flavourings and appetisers, etc.

Heading 85.14 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers, among others, other industrial or laboratory equipment for the heat treatment of materials by induction or dielectric loss. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that the heading also includes electric induction or dielectric heating equipment, even if not in the form of a furnace or oven. This equipment (used mainly for the heat treatment of small articles) consists essentially of electrical equipment for producing high-frequency oscillations, mounted together with the appropriate plates or coils, often of special design for the particular articles to be treated.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 8514.40.00, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of zero and ASEAN Trade in Goods Agreement (ATIGA) rate of duty of zero, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "D".

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

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

4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

"RENADYL™"

Based on the product label, product composition, and brochure submitted, subject article is a probiotic dietary supplement for maintaining healthy kidney function in the form of capsule. It contains *S. thermophilus, L. acidophilus, B. longum*, xylo oligosaccharide, inulin, and magnesium stearate (excipient). It is formulated to regulate bloodstream concentrations of nitrogenous waste metabolites and to stabilize healthy gut flora. Packed in plastic bottles containing 60 capsules, subject article is taken 1-2 capsules twice daily with a meal, or as recommended by the physician.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 21.06 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers food preparations not elsewhere specified or included. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that provided that they are not covered by any other heading of the Nomenclature, this heading covers, among others, preparations, often referred to as *food supplements*, based on extracts from plants, fruit concentrates, honey, fructose, etc. and containing added vitamins and sometimes minute quantities of iron compounds. These preparations are often put up in packagings with indications that they maintain general health or well-being. Similar preparations, however, intended for the prevention or treatment of diseases or ailments are excluded (heading 30.03 or 30.04).

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 2106.90.72, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 7% ad valorem.

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

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4 DESCRIPTION OF GOOD

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"PROFERRIN® ES (HEME IRON POLYPEPTIDE) TABLET"

Based on the product catalog, composition of finished product, certificate of product registration from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), and photograph of packaging submitted, subject article is an iron supplement containing heme iron polypeptide as active ingredient, croscarmellose sodium and povidone as disintegrants, silicon dioxide as flow aid, calcium stearate as release agent, and microcrystalline cellulose as excipient. It is in the form of green tablets and produced by hydrolysis of bovine haemoglobin resulting in a highly soluble heme moiety. Packed in high density polyethylene (HDPE) bottles containing 30 tablets and 90 tablets, subject article is to be taken one tablet daily with food or as recommended by the physician. With high absorption rate and low side effects, it helps maintain and support healthy iron levels necessary for oxygen transport, red blood cell production and sustained energy levels.

5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 30.02 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers, among others, antisera, other blood fractions and immunological products, whether or not modified or obtained by means of biotechnological processes. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) covers products including, among others, antisera and other blood fractions, whether or not modified or obtained by means of biotechnological processes. The heading covers, *inter alia*, products derived from blood (including vascular endothelial cells): "normal" sera, human normal immunoglobulin, blood fractions and truncated variants (parts) thereof with enzymatic properties/activity, plasma, thrombin, fibrinogen, fibrin and other blood coagulation factors, thrombomodulin, blood globulins, serum globulins, and haemoglobin. This group also includes modified thrombomodulins and modified haemoglobins obtained by means of biotechnological processes, e.g., sothrombomodulin alfa (INN) and thrombomodulin alfa (INN), as well as cross-linked haemoglobins such as hemoglobin crosfumaril (INN), hemoglobin glutamer (INN) and hemoglobin raffimer (INN). The products of this heading remain classified here whether or not in measured doses or put up for retail sale and whether in bulk or in small packings.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 3002.12.90, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 3% ad valorem.

"KTABSR POTASSIUM CHLORIDE"

Based on the certificate of product registration from the Food and Drug Administration (FDA), product information, photograph of product and label submitted, subject article is a prolonged-release potassium prescription drug in the form of opaque white to pearl white, oval, plain tablet. It consists of potassium chloride as active ingredient and silica colloidal anhydrous, ethylcellulose, stearyl alcohol, surelease[®] clear, hypromellose, talc, and purified water. Packed in high density polyethylene (HDPE) plastic bottles containing 250 tablets, subject article is indicated for the prevention and treatment of hypokalemia with or without metabolic alkalosis, digitalis intoxication, and hypokalemic familial periodic paralysis.



5 REASONS FOR CLASSIFICATION

Heading 30.04 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers medicaments (excluding goods of heading 30.02, 30.05 or 30.06) consisting of mixed or unmixed products for therapeutic or prophylactic uses, put up in measured doses (including those in the form of transdermal administration systems) or in forms or packings for retail sale. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that this heading covers medicaments consisting of mixed or unmixed products, provided they are, among others, put up in measured doses or in forms such as tablets, ampoules, capsules, cachets, drops or pastilles, medicaments in the form of transdermal administration systems, or small quantities of powder, ready for taking as single doses for therapeutic or prophylactic use. The heading applies to such single doses whether in bulk, in packings for retail sale, etc.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 3004.90.99 with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 5% ad valorem and ASEAN-India Free Trade Area (AIFTA) rate of duty of 1% ad valorem from 01 January to 30 December 2018 and zero from 31 December 2018 onwards, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "AI".

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.

Heading 40.11 of the ASEAN Harmonized Tariff Nomenclature (AHTN) 2017 covers new pneumatic tyres, of rubber. The pertinent Harmonized System (HS) Explanatory Notes (EN) state that these tyres may be for use on any type of vehicle or aircraft, on wheeled toys, machinery, artillery weapons, etc. They may or may not require inner tubes.

In view thereof, subject article is classified under AHTN 2017 subheading 4011.20.10, with a Most Favoured Nation (MFN) rate of duty of 7% ad valorem and ASEAN-China Free Trade Area (ACFTA) rate of duty of 5% ad valorem, subject to submission of Certificate of Origin (CO) Form "E".

This ruling shall be valid for five (5) years from the date of issuance and shall continue to apply unless the law, facts, or circumstances supporting this ruling have changed.
