Initially, the BESF target of the Bureau was given an increase of Php13.59B from Php581.291B to Php594.881B due to the expected revenues to be generated from the fuel marking program. However, since fuel marking has not yet commenced and therefore no revenue can be generated until this program has been implemented, the DOF granted the appeal of the Bureau and reduced the initial increase in the BESF target by Php10B.

For the remaining Php3.59B, attached to this memorandum is the Cash Target Allocation of the Collection Districts for the month of December.

At this point, I would like to congratulate the performance of the Collection Districts that has led to a year-to-date surplus of almost Php15B. However, we cannot afford to rest our laurels until the last working day of the year and in fact all district collectors are enjoined to strive harder to increase their collection efforts that will redound to a bigger surplus for the Bureau.
